STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 24038: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., and the N/2S/2 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Stage Fright 12/7 Fed. Com. Well No. 616H, with a first take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 12 and a last take point in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 7.

Case No. 24039: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., and the S/2S/2 of Section 7 and the SW/4SW/4 of Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Stage Fright 12/8 Fed. Com. Well No. 618H, with a first take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 12 and a last take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 8.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a cost plus 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing testing, and equipping the wells.


