

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 18 and the W/2E/2 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the W/2E/2 of Section 18 and the W/2E/2 of Section 7 (containing 320 acres), and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the North Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 8H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 18 and a last take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 7.
