**APPLICATION** 

Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order R-22225-A to allow additional time to commence drilling the initial well authorized by the pooling order. In support of its application, Matador states:

1. On August 29, 2022, the Division issued Order R-22225 in Case No. 22418 creating a standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation (WC-025 G-08 S253534O; Bone Spring [97088]) comprised of the E/2 SW/4 of Section 18, the E/2 W/2 of Section 19, and the E/2 NW/4 of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"). Matador is the designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22225 dedicates the Unit to the proposed **Lonnie King Fed Com 136H** well.

2. On September 11, 2023, the Division issued Order No. R-22225-A extending the time to commence drilling the initial well to August 29, 2024.

3. Good cause now exists to extend the drilling deadline to August 29, 2025.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 8, 2024, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order extending the time for Matador to commence drilling the initial well authorized by Order R-22225.

#### <u>ORDER</u>

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on August 3, 2023, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Matador Production Company ("Operator") submitted an application ("Application") requesting an extension to drill the well(s) as required by Order R-22225, as amended ("Order").
- 2. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice of the Application was given.
- 3. Operator has demonstrated good cause to extend the deadlines in the Order.
- 4. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 5. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
- 6. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
- 7. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.

#### <u>ORDER</u>

- 8. The period to drill the well(s) is extended until August 29, 2024.
- 9. This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 7 unless prior to termination Operator applies, and OCD grants, to amend the Order for good cause shown.

#### **SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF DAVID JOHNS**

David Johns, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

- 1. My name is David Johns. I work MRC Energy Company, an affiliate of Matador Production Company ("Matador"), as an Area Land Manager.
- 2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
- 3. I am familiar with the application filed by Matador in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.
- 4. On August 29, 2022, the Division issued Order R-22225 in Case No. 22418 creating a standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation (WC-025 G-08 S253534O; Bone Spring [97088]) comprised of the E/2 SW/4 of Section 18, the E/2 W/2 of Section 19, and the E/2 NW/4 of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit"). Matador is the designated operator of the Unit and Order R-22225 dedicates the Unit to the proposed **Lonnie King Fed Com 136H** well.
- 5. On September 11, 2023, the Division issued Order No. R-22225-A extending the time to commence drilling the initial well to August 29, 2024.
- 6. Matador is eager to develop this acreage and has previously filed its application for a federal APD for the initial well in September 2021. Matador has been unable to drill the initial

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well yet because our federal APD has not been approved. We understand the permit approval was previously delayed after third-party litigation was initiated against the Bureau of Land Management regarding certain of its permitting approval processes. We understand the Bureau of Land Management now has a process in place for the review and approval of the drilling permits that were implicated in the litigation and we are optimistic that we will receive an approved drilling permit during the requested extension period of the pooling order.

- 7. Once Matador's previously filed federal APD is approved, Matador intends to promptly drill the initial well under the order. Good cause therefore exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling under the order for a year, until August 29, 2025.
- 8. Matador does not have any further updates to the updated summary of interests with respect to this pooling order.
- 9. None of the working interest owners that remain subject to these pooling orders have been asked at this time to make an election on the applicable well, or to pay their estimated share of the costs to drill, complete and equip the applicable well.
  - 10. The granting of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
- 11. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.
