## **STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Targa seeks authorization to inject treated acid gas ("TAG") from its Copperhead Gas Processing ("Plant") into the proposed Copperhead AGI No. 1 Well ("Well"), to be located in Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The Well is an Underground Injection Control ("UIC") Class II well subject to the requirements of 19.15.26 NMAC. The Well will be drilled as a vertical well with a surface location approximately 793 feet from the south line (FSL) and 429 feet from the east line (FEL) of Section 13. The Well will inject TAG into the Devonian Thirtyone, Upper Silurian Wristen, and Lower Silurian Fusselman Formations at a depth of approximately 17,299 feet to 18,689 feet. The Well's proposed maximum daily injection rate is twenty-six (26) million standard cubic feet per day ("MMSCFD"), and the proposed maximum surface injection pressure will be approximately 3,460 pounds per square inch gauge ("psig").

The Well, as proposed in the C-108, will not cause waste, impair correlative rights, or harm public health or the environment, including through the risk of induced seismicity. In addition, the Well will facilitate the sequestration of CO2 and TAG, which is in the public interest. Accordingly, Targa's application for the Well is reasonable, comports with the requirements of the Oil and Gas Act, and should be approved.
