## **APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

In Case No. 24923, MRC seeks to amend pooling Order R-22682 to add additional mineral interest owners to the pooling order. On May 12, 2023, the Division entered Order R-22682 in Case No. 23418 and pooled uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Rock Lake; Bone Spring, South Pool [52769] and WC-025 G-06 S233516M; Middle Bone Spring Pool [98246]) underlying the E/2 SE/4 of Section 4, and the E/2 E/2 of Sections 9 and 16, Township 23 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This standard 400-acre

horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Marlan Downey**State Com 124H well.

Applicant has discovered additional mineral interest owners in the pooled acreage that were not subject to the pooling proceeding giving rise to Order R-22682. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from these additional mineral interest owners and requests to add them under the existing order.
