Colgate Production, LLC ("Applicant") submits its Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant requests a one-year extension of time, until February 28, 2026, to commence drilling the wells authorized by Order No. R-23078 ("Order"). The Division issued the Order in Case No. 24080 on February 28, 2024. The Order: (1) pooled uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 318.59 acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, and the N/2 N/2 of irregular Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit"); (2) dedicated the Unit to the **Mojo 30-25 Fed Com 111H**, **Mojo 30-25 Fed Com 121H**, **and Mojo** 

**30-25 Fed Com 131H** wells ("Wells"); and (3) designated Permian Resources Operating, LLC (OGRID No. 372165) ("Permian Resources") as operator of the Unit and Wells.

A one year extension of time to commence drilling the Wells has been requested because the spud date has been delayed until May 2025 to allow Permian Resources to obtain production results from offset acreage and ensure optimal well spacing. Therefore, good cause exists for the requested extension.

Additionally, since the Order was entered, Applicant has identified additional uncommitted interests that should be pooled into the Unit to allow Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands.
