15 Thank you.

16 Good morning, everyone.

17 It is 8:58 AM on November the 20th.

18 This is the second regular docket of the oil Conservation divisions monthly hearings.

19 We are hearing status conferences today and we are going to begin with four cases  
20 that are joined together, 2 matador cases, 25595 and nine six and two earthstone  
21 cases 25717 and 1/8.

22 Entries of appearance please.

23 Good morning. Jackie McLean, on behalf of Earthstone operating morning.

26 Good morning, Mr. hearing examiner.

27

29 Window.

30 Morning, Miss Vance.

32 **PV Paula M. Vance 1:36:26**

33 Sorry.

34 Good morning, Mr. hearing examiner Paula Vance with the Santa Fe Office of Holland  
35 and Heart on behalf of Matador production Company and \*\*\* \*\*\*\*\* Jones cases.

**PH** Pecos Hall 1:36:39

38 Good morning, Mr. Examiner.

39 Deanna Bennett, on behalf of Kotera Energy operating and Simrix Energy Company  
40 of Colorado and what is your position?

41 We objected to all four of these cases and kotera is planning on filing competing  
42 applications.

43 These cases are already set for a contested hearing on January 27th, and Kotera is  
44 planning on filing competing applications, which would be in time for the January  
45 27th docket.

46 But also.

47 Between last night.

48 And today, Kotera and MRC reached an agreement and MRC. It's my understanding  
49 and I'll let Miss Vance confirm that, that MRC is going to be dismissing its cases and  
50 supporting kotera as operator moving forward.

51 Kotera and MRC are working on a JOA that MRC is going to join and support kotera,  
52 and so Kotera is hopeful that Permian Resources will follow suit and dismiss its  
53 competing applications and its objections, especially in light of the fact that.

54 MRC is going to be now supporting Kotera, and it's my understanding that Mr. or  
55 Permian Resources has indicated a willingness to do so if kotera is named as  
56 operator so. So what?

57 I understand so far from you, Miss Bennett.

58 Is that you believe based on ajoa that Matador, I have matador here.

59 I don't if it's matador.

60 Or not.

61 Matador will end up dismissing its competing cases with Earthstone and Kotera will  
62 be filing the competing cases with EARTHSTONE.

63 That's right, although hopefully Permian.

64 I'm sorry. Earth Stone, which is also Permian, but Earthstone will be dismissing its  
65 competing applications as well, leaving kotera the ability to move forward  
66 uncontested.

67 That's Kotera's ultimate hope.

68 And.

69 So that's and it's my understanding that.

70 Permian Resources Earthstone has indicated that it would dismiss its competing  
71 applications if kotera were to be. If Kotera and MRC were to be aligned OK.

82 Sharon Shaheen, on behalf of Elephant Cone properties and the estate of Kenneth G

83 Cone, we entered an appearance in \*\*\* \*\*\*\*\* Jones cases.

84 We did not file an objection and we are simply monitoring.

88 Thank you, machine.

89 Are there any other entries of appearance?

90 No. All right.

91 Let's go back to you.

92 Let's go back to you. M's McLean is this news to you?

93 Yes, yesterday I figured it was.

94 Yes, Earthstone was saying.

95 They are ready to proceed forward with the January 27th contested hearing and

96 that's all I have for you today.

97 All right.

98 Sounds good.

99 Do you know about any?

100 Were you aware of any of these negotiations?

101 Between Kotara and and Matador.

102 No, I was not OK.

103 We've just been proceeding forward like we're going to contested hearing. Did did

104 you know that it was kotera's intent to file competing cases?

105 Yes, I think Miss Ben Benin said that the last.  
106 The last status conference and so the client was aware of that they had received  
107 proposals and they.  
108 At the time and as of yesterday, we're not wanting to join with KOTERA or MRC, but  
109 you know, I'm certainly going to take all this information back and see if their  
110 position has changed, M's Vance.

113 Yes, I'll confirm with Miss Bennett, said matador.  
114 We are working on filing a motion to dismiss our cases and that was going to be my  
115 update and we have reached a agreement with Kotera and we will be supporting.  
116 Matador will be supporting kotera's operator.  
117 In their proposals.

118

120 OK.  
121 Yes, I understood, Miss Bennett.  
122 When do you believe you're filing the kotera competing cases?  
123 Thank you.  
124 I sent drafts to Kotara yesterday. The proposal letters were sent out on October 23rd,  
125 so I started working on the drafts of the application.  
126 So I should be able to file them either.  
127 It might be a push to file them this week, but early next week I would be able to file  
128 them. OK, very good.  
129 So then that would be on the early.  
130 I mean, if there were no competing cases, that would be on the early January docket.  
131 For affidavit, unless they're objected to and.  
132 And they'll be part of this.  
133 January 27 contested hearing? Yes, at the last hearing at the last status conference  
134 you asked that I joined the kotara cases with the competing cases, right?  
135 And so yes, they will be.  
136 I'll be requesting the 1st January docket with the understanding that if Permian does  
137 not withdraw its objection, then we will be moving to.  
138 Sorry, Earth stone does not withdraw. Objection.  
139 Or objects to the cases that they will be heard as a contested hearing on January

140 27th. OK.  
141 But from your understanding kotera and Earthstone could not proceed by affidavit.  
142 Unless one of them dismisses.  
143 That's right.  
144 These are overlapping.  
145 Development plans.  
146 And and that's a curious word. When you say overlapping when you say overlapping.  
147 You mean obviously competing but overlapping is a different term, isn't it?  
148 They're competing, but they don't have a 100% overlap, so it's not a 100% overlap.  
149 So there's some overlapping acreage and I did draw a map, but I don't have it handy.  
150 That's OK.  
151 I get that.  
152 But yeah, that's it's not a one for one. In other words, as I recall. OK, perfect.  
153 Alright, excellent.  
154 And when you do file your applications.  
155 Let's say next week, would you file a motion to?  
156 To join them and amend the pre hearing order.  
157 Yes, I will. All right.  
158 Perfect. Is there anything else? Not for me.  
159 Thank you, miss McLean.  
160 Nothing from earthstone.  
161 All right.  
162 Thank you, miss Miss Vance.

165 Nothing from Matador will file that motion to dismiss today.

170 We're off the record in those four cases.

173 Good morning, Mr. hearing examiner Caitlin Locke for the applicant in this case,

174 Waterloo Resources.

175 Good morning.  
176 Good morning, Mr. Examiner.  
177 Dina Bennett, on behalf of Avant operating, too, and Avant has objected to this case  
178 moving forward by affidavit.  
179 Thank you, miss Bennett.  
180 Good morning, Mr. Examiner.  
181 Dayna Hardy with Hardy McLane, on behalf of Powderhorn and Powderhorn, is also  
182 objected to this application.  
183 Proceeding by affidavit. Thank you.  
184 Good morning, Mr. Examiner.  
185 Jordan Kessler, on behalf of Eug Resources.  
186 And we've also objected to the application, yeah.  
187 So you objected.  
188 That's that's a novel.  
189 That's a novel.  
190 One for you, isn't it quite interesting? I thought it was.  
191 Yes. Are there any other entries?

210 Holland and Heart on behalf of Matador, who is who made an entry of appearance  
211 and objected and also on behalf of Oxy.  
212 Oxy is just monitoring.  
213 We only entered an appearance on behalf of Oxy.

216 All right.  
217 Thank you.

218

219 **MS** **Miguel Suazo** 1:44:39

220 Good morning, Mr. Examiner.  
221 Miguel Suazo with beating Woznack, appearing today on behalf of Riley Permian for  
222 purposes of monitoring and preserving rights only.

223

224 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 1:44:48

225 All right.  
226 Thank you, Mr. Swatho.  
227 All right, miss luck.  
228 Thank you. This morning I did receive confirmation, I think from the last couple of  
229 parties that were involved in this case that I had requested everyone's concurrence  
230 before the hearing today about setting this for another status conference in  
231 December, if possible, because I don't think this case.  
232 Is ready for a contested hearing.  
233 There's still been some trades that are ongoing currently, and I think it's in  
234 Waterloo's best best interest to wait to set contested hearings.  
235 So if we could have another status conference in December, that would be our  
236 preference and look towards maybe February contested hearing docket if possible.  
237 Did you receive the list of possible hearing dates?  
238 Yes, from Freya. You did. OK, good. So wanted to make sure you got that.  
239 I looked at my notes.  
240 This case was filed August 19.  
241 There are a bunch of objections.  
242 I realize that they're mostly.  
243 Mostly negotiating.  
244 Tactics.

245 Do you know if anyone's planning on filing a competing application?  
246 I'm not sure if anyone's intending on filing a competing application.  
247 I did understand from my client this morning that Marathon had sold their interest to  
248 Permian and so that might be a change where Permian may decide to file an  
249 application. But I can't speak on behalf of any of those parties.  
250 Unfortunately, I can just say what my client has told me this morning.  
251 I just thought you might have heard.  
252 Let me ask from all the parties that are objecting, is anyone planning on filing a  
253 competing application?  
254 Yes, Mr. Examiner Powderhorn is planning to file a competing application.  
255 And Powder Horn is an operator here in New Mexico.  
256 Yes, OK.  
257 Thank you.  
258 Are there any others that?  
259 Are no Mr. Examiner, EOG the basis of Eog's objection to this application is related to  
260 existing wellbores in the area and concern over anti collusion measures.  
261 So that's the basis of our objection and we're hoping to work through that with the  
262 applicant interesting.  
263 Thank you.  
264 So in other words, in other words, you'll try to get them to adjust where they put  
265 their well and have a drill it OK.  
266 I see that's correct.  
267 And then you would withdraw your objection. OK. And Miss Hardy, since I didn't  
268 hear anyone else. I didn't hear from.  
269 Anyone else with their objection?  
270 Because Miss Bennett, you. You're. What was your objection based on?  
271 Our objection is based on the development plan and at this point.  
272 I am not sure whether Avante is going to be submitting competing applications.  
273 I don't.  
274 I'm not saying I'm they are.  
275 They aren't.  
276 I don't have any information on that, so I can't answer the question. OK, I understand.  
277 Thanks. So miss Hardy.  
278 When would you?  
279 When would you anticipate filing your application so Powderhorn is sending out its

280 well proposals this week?  
281 OK. And so allowing for the 30 days then to file, I think we would be on the 1st  
282 February docket.  
283 Got it.  
284 OK.  
285 Well, that's good to hear.  
286 Thank you for telling me that.  
287 So, Miss luck, what I'm gonna do is I'm gonna set this for a contested hearing in  
288 February.  
289 And then if you wanna have another status conference before that, that's fine. You  
290 can move your case to that, whether it be December docket or January status  
291 conference docket for a final status conference.  
292 But I did note in my notes from the last.  
293 October status conference that I said this was gonna be.  
294 The final time that I would continue this without setting a contested hearing.  
295 So if I'm not mistaken, there's one docket in February for a for a contested hearing,  
296 and that would be February 10.  
297 So please check with your client and your witnesses.  
298 But we're we're gonna issue a pre hearing order for February 10 if for some reason  
299 that is just not works, you know, submit an affidavit.  
300 From a witness saying why they can't participate on February 10 and I think we might  
301 have February 26 as a backup as the 2nd February contested hearing docket.  
302 OK.  
303 Thank you very much, of course.  
304 Is there anything further from Miss Hardy?  
305 No, thank you, miss Bennett. Nothing further.  
306 Thank you. Any other party.  
307 No. All right, we're off the record.  
308 In that case, let's move on now to Powderhorn operating.  
309 Interesting. We were just talking about this is 25610 entries please.

341 and we entered an appearance and objected.

342 We do plan on sending out competing proposals regarding this acreage.

346 Can you be more specific?

351 are in the works being prepared but they have not gone out yet.  
352 So once those goes, those proposals go out, we'll let them run their course. The 30  
353 days and then we will file competing applications 30 days after those proposals  
354 going out so.

425 I did wanna just let you know that avant is planning on filing competing applications  
426 as well. And in terms of your question about the timing, I unfortunately don't have  
427 that information.

429 Right. Mr. holiday. Sounds like this is getting to be crowded here and I hear that  
430 three different operators are planning on competing with your proposal.

445 docket.

458 So I expect those to be joined together on this as well.

464 It's also Powderhorn operating.

465

467 You mean 2561?

468 Oh, should be joined with 25753 and five four.

469

470 **BH** **Benjamin Holliday** 1:54:14

471 Well, these the bone spring cases overlap the Wolfcamp case and at least Toteria has  
472 objected to both. And so I would expect those to be considered at the same time.

473

475 Yeah.

477 **BH** **Benjamin Holliday** 1:54:25

478 Or or not.

479 I mean, it's at the division's preference, obviously.

480

483 I have notes here that I was gonna ask Freya or Mada E to join 25610 with 25753 and  
484 five four.

485 They're on.

486 Are they on another docket?

487 25 those two cases.

488

490 Yes, Sir. They were filed a month after, so they're they're not up yet.

491 That's that's the lag time.

492

494 I see. OK, OK. OK. And you're representing Powderhorn in those cases too?

495

496 **BH Benjamin Holliday** 1:54:54

497 Yes, Sir.

498

499 **PH Pecos Hall** 1:54:55

500 Oh, OK. All right, got it.

501 And are these competing case or?

502 Are these potentially or these proposals from from kotera and from marathon?

503 Are they all competing with just?

504 One formation or both formations?

505

506 **BH Benjamin Holliday** 1:55:16

507 They, you know, allow myself to be corrected.

508 My understanding is that the objections we've just discussed relate to and the

509 counter proposals we've discussed from marathon avant.

510 And Kotera would be for the Wolfcamp case, the only party that I believe that.

511

513 Both can.

514

515 **BH Benjamin Holliday** 1:55:35

516 So that would be 25610. The only party I believe that has objected to the Bone

517 Spring cases has been the kotara group and I am not aware if they've sent counter

518 proposals.

523 **BH Benjamin Holliday** 1:55:46

524 Those are not on those properties.

530 I I can clarify that Mister Examiner, sure.

531

533 I was hoping you would go right ahead.

534

536 So I as I understand it, cottera is prepared to send the Wolfcamp proposals out next  
537 week. However, with respect to the Bone Spring, they're going to send those out  
538 sometime in December.

543 I was gonna come to you next.

544 Thank you.

545 I did file an entry of appearance on behalf of Avant in the first phone spring case that  
546 was discussed.

548 entry of appearance and objection in that case as well.

549 Do you think your you think your client Avant will?

550 Want will have competing proposals.

551 For those for that formation as well, I'm not sure about that.

552 I only learned of these cases yesterday, alright?

553 And let's see.

554 Miss Vance, you said you're gonna have a proposal for the wolf camp.

555 Are you gonna have proposals for the Bone Spring as well?

558 I'm not sure I'm looking through my e-mail to see if I got any reference to  
559 bonespring. To my knowledge right now it's just gonna be Wolf camp.

560

562 I see. OK.

563 Wow. All right, sounds good.

564 So mighty. Will you join those three cases for the purpose of a contested hearing?

565 And Miss Bennett, Mr. Suazo and Miss Vance, when you do file your competing  
566 applications.

567 Would you please file motions to?

568 Join those three cases, or at least you know the proper formation case so that we can  
569 keep things straight here.

570 Mr. holiday.

571 Do you wanna set it?

572 Contested hearing down the road or what?

573

575 I think our preference would would have been to grab that February 10 date. It  
576 sounds like that's maybe spoken for.

577 So I think, yeah, I think there's there is going to be a change position.

578 I think there's deals to be made here, but our our preference would be to set a  
579 contested hearing and then let that shake out as it's shake out.

621 heard. But practically speaking, given the positions of the parties and you know all  
622 that needs to go out with the proposals and applications, I think you know March  
623 would be realistically SPE.

624 The earliest this could happen sounds like.

625 Miss Vance agrees with that.

626

628 Mr. Holiday, it's your they're your cases.

629 How do you feel about it?

630

631 **BH** **Benjamin Holliday** 2:00:04

632 Well, I'll just ask you a procedural question. If we were to hold the 26th date, could I

633 have an opportunity to confer with Mr. Suazo and Miss Vance about those days?

634

636 Of course, sure.

639 Yeah. So I would say my preference would be to hold the 26th date because

640 Powderhorn is interested in moving this along as quickly as possible.

712 Along with Mr. Suazo, we would prefer a date out in March or later, and I understand  
713 you said you didn't want a later date, but there's a lot of moving parts here, and it's  
714 Marathon's preference to push for a contested hearing in March or a later date.

720 Great than that. Thank you.

770 and Heart. On behalf of the applicant, Mack Energy.

773 Thank you.

774 And Jackie McLean, with Hardy McClain representing MRNM. And I believe these two  
775 cases when I say two cases, I didn't call your case, Miss McLean.

776 But no. Yeah, we've had the status conference on that earlier this month and I believe  
777 these are set for January 27th, correct. Alright, sounds good, Miss Vance.

778 What? What is it that you'd like to tell me?

779

781 I mean, this was already set, but the only thing that I would state on the record is and  
782 I we kind of got into this at the last status conferences at this point regarding the  
783 overlapping acreage between the two contested cases.

784 Mac does have a agreement in the works with XTO, so they will have the working  
785 interest control in the overlapping acreage and to Miss Mclean's point at the last  
786 hearing.

787 You know, regarding wasting the division's time and you know, not going to a

802 looks at when they are reviewing or looking at contested and in particular

803 overlapping contested acre or competing cases, who has either the majority working

804 interest control or ownership. And in this case.

805 We'll be able to show that Mac has the all of the working interest control in the

806 overlapping acreage.

807

809 So correct me if I'm wrong here, because I'm I I wanna understand your point fully.

810 So let's say that.

811 So let's say that we have two proposals and they overlap in, in in one area.

812 But then there's the other area outside that overlapping.

813 Area does the division look at just who has the majority of control in the overlapping

814 area or does it look at the the percentage of interests in the whole proposed area?

815

816 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 2:06:23

817 They will primarily look at and I am trying to find in my notes on the order that

818 discusses overlapping.

819 Factors that the division looks at but their prior the division. Primarily they're going

820 to look at the overlapping acreage because if a party has the working interest control

821 in their own acreage, they can do whatever they want with it.

824 I see.

825

826 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 2:06:45

827 But the contest is over the overlapping acreage.

828

829 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 2:06:49

830 So. So what I understand you're saying is Mac has 100% interest in some area and

831 then it's it may have depending on whether you, whether you finalize this agreement  
832 or not with this other party or XTO. I think you said.

833

834 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 2:07:07

835 That's correct.

836

837 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 2:07:08

838 If you are able to finalize the agreement with XTO, then you would have basically the  
839 the control of not only the overlapping area but of course your area as well. That's  
840 what you're saying.

841

842 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 2:07:22

843 That's correct.

844 That's correct.

845

846 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 2:07:24

847 And you're saying that, OK.

848 Well, let's see what?

849 Let's see what spec has to say.

850 I disagree with everything that.

851 First of all, we are also working on XTL.

852 As I said, the last time, there's lots of potential deals here.

853 Secondly, I believe we had a case earlier this year with Viero where the division made  
854 clear that you look at the entire spacing unit and the interest ownership over the  
855 entire acreage, not just one particular tract which Miss Vance continues to want to  
856 do. In this case as.

857 Well, as the Fiero case.

858 So I believe you know we are ready and we're proceeding forward to that January  
859 27th.

860 Contested hearing.

861 I don't think it will be a waste of anyone's time because we have very valid reasons to  
862 want to develop our acreage and we are also working on a deal ourselves.

863 OK. Thank you. As as I thought, Miss Vance, I thought miss.

867 I've got one other thought that I I I would like to respond to Miss McLean.

873 OK.

874 Well, one the overlapping factors, if you'd like to reference them, Mr. hearing

875 examiner, that's order number 21416.

876

878 And is that a Commission?

879 I'm sorry, Ms. Vance. Commission order or division order.

880

881 **PV Paula M. Vance** 2:08:46

882 Believe that's a division order.

883

884 **PH Pecos Hall** 2:08:48

885 OK, 21416 OK.

886

887 **PV Paula M. Vance** 2:08:50

888 That's that's correct.

889 One, I would say that I I wanna be clear that the case that Miss McLean is referencing

890 regarding Fierro is that is that has nothing to do with the case that we're talking

891 about right here. And in that case, it's one set of competing applications and a J.

892 That's involved and those are distinguished from what we were dealing with right

893 here, which are two compulsory pooling cases that are overlapping.

894 So again, that's distinguishable.

895 And to it's my understanding also that XTO has already communicated to MNRM

896 that they will not be supporting them, that they're going to be supporting our client.

897 So the idea that there are all these deals to be made, I'm not sure when the last time

898 M's McLean talked with her client, but it's my understanding that XTO has

899 communicated to them very clearly that they are not going to be supporting them,

900 that they will.

901 Be supporting.

905 OK. Can I also chime in with your thoughts?

906 We're just gonna go back and forth. I'd like to say that the order number R 21416 is  
907 the BTA case that describes the competing factors and that also had to do with the  
908 JOA.

909 So you know, a lot of things have to do with Jo as and the concepts still apply to  
910 competing.

911 Or contested compulsory pooling applications.

912 I talked with my client yesterday.

913 I don't know.

914 Like, I don't think that that's really important.

915 What people are saying, I'm sure Mac is telling Miss Vance one thing I'm getting told

940 and Hart, on behalf of Matador.

941 And we did enter an appearance and objection to both of the cases.

942 We are withdrawing our objection to the Wolfcamp, but we will be sending out  
943 proposals for the Bone Spring that compete with admiral's cases.

948 So M's Hardy is it then it sounds like you would be able to move forward on one of

1010 see it and and recognize it as what it is. That's all I care about.

1013 I will make sure to follow up.

1014

1015 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 2:14:13

1016 All right, perfect. Thank you.

1017 Is there anything else, Miss Vance?

1018

1019 **PV** **Paula M. Vance** 2:14:17

1020 Not for me, no.

1021

1022 **PH** **Pecos Hall** 2:14:18

1023 Miss Hardy.

1024 No, thank you.

1025 OK, wonderful.

1026 We're off the record in those two cases, I'm just.

1027 I'm just curious.

1028 M's Hardy.

1029 Why do you think January 8 is a better day? To hear your affidavit than December 4?

1030 I think that I'd have to go.

1031 I think that that date just worked better for our witnesses. We need to be available.

1032 All right.

1033 Well, look if you.

1034 It's within your control to move it to either docket you want to.

1035 I was just trying to give it priority.

1036 Appreciate that very much because we the December is full already.

1037 I know, but I.

1038 But I'd be happy to add it to that because this case has been filed a while ago and I'd

1039 like to move it along I can.  
1040 Can I'll confirm with my with my client if you find that the December works. If you  
1041 find that December works for you.  
1042 You're authorized to move it to December, but please send an e-mail to Freya and let  
1043 her know our discussion and that I said that I would put it at the beginning.  
1044 Of the December docket.  
1045 OK, to make sure it's heard. OK. Thank you.  
1046 I appreciate that very much.  
1047 We're off the record in those two cases.  
1048 Let's move on to yet another powder horn case.  
1049 This is 25722 Dana Hardy on behalf of Powderhorn Excellent.

1052 Miguel Suazo with Baden Wozniak on behalf of Kotera, Magnum Hunter and  
1053 Cimorex.

1055 **PH Pecos Hall 2:15:41**

1056 And you objected.

1057

1058 **MS Miguel Suazo 2:15:43**

1059 Yes.

1060

1061 **PH Pecos Hall 2:15:44**

1062 OK, for and what's the what are you trying to get out of this?

1063

1064 **MS Miguel Suazo 2:15:47**

1065 Well, I think that Cotera has some issues with the development plan those proposed.

1066 I know that the parties are still negotiating terms, but at this point not uncertain as to  
1067 whether or not they'll be fruitful.

1068 Coterra is prepared to take this to a contested hearing, and we'll be submitting  
1069 competing applications.

1070

1072 Mm-hmm.

1073 So it is so in other words, if your negotiations don't go as as as as hoped for, you  
1074 would submit proposals.

1087 December and then we'll send out applications, you know, once the deadline passes,

1134 Yeah. When I saw your objection, I was quite surprised.

1135 OK, Miss Hardy, how do you want to proceed?

1139 How do you want to proceed?

1173 Before I go to Miss McLean and miss Miss Luck, what what's your objective here?

1174

1176 Right now I believe that matador and Avant are negotiating, so to my knowledge,  
1177 matador is not planning on sending out competing proposals.

1178

1179 **PH Pecos Hall** 2:18:59

1180 Oh.

1181 OK.

1182 All right.

1183 And I'll come to you, Miss Bennett, in just a moment.

1184 Go ahead, Miss McLean.

1185 Yes, Jackie McLean with Hardy McClain on behalf of Permian Resources and we've  
1186 objected and your objective is we are going to pile competing applications. Very  
1187 good. Thank you.

1188 And miss luck. Good morning again, Mr. Hein Examiner Kaitlyn Locke, appearing for  
1189 WR Non OP LLC, which is Waterloo's non operating interest and not objecting in this  
1190 case just observing and preserving rights.

1191 Thank you.

1192 Perfect. Thank you, miss luck.

1193 Miss McLean, before I go back to Miss Bennett, any ideas on when you might be  
1194 sending out proposals?

1195 If you haven't already, I believe they've already gone out and I believe that we're

1205 Permian?

1206 Nothing and Avon owns 78%.

1208 We're gonna go to hearing, OK? And so if.

1209 In fact, Permian Resources does in fact file competing applications. Then any of the  
1210 two January dates will work for Avant January 13th, January 27th and even the  
1211 February 10th, OK date and.

1212 And what I would ask though, is to set a contested hearing, but also.

1213 I would like to file a continuance for these two cases to the December 18th docket, of  
1214 course, so that we can have a status conference to see if Permian follows through  
1215 with its competing applications.  
1216 That's you have authority to do that, of course.  
1217 So Miss McLean, if we set this for a 27 January.  
1218 Contested hearing. Does that work for you?  
1219 I believe we have several other contested hearings that date already, but you know  
1220 how these are.  
1221 Yeah, I mean, they'll all go away.  
1222 That's fine.  
1223 I mean, my preference would be, I mean we are going.  
1224 I have drafted the applications.  
1225 I don't why everyone's doubting.  
1226 My follow through today, but I'm I'm going to be filing.  
1227 I think what you know, so we don't waste time and come back on yet another status  
1228 conference.

1230 We file the applications, they can object.  
1231 They'll automatically get on the status conference before this contested hearing date,  
1232 so they can see if we filed by checking the docket. And I can also send her Miss  
1233 Bennett a copy.  
1234 If she like but, but my question to you was, does the January 27 contested hearing  
1235 date work for you?  
1236 I would have to ask the clients I 'cause I just I I don't know if they're. If the we have  
1237 the other Permian Resources contested hearing that day, but this is another set of  
1238 witnesses. So I would have to make sure that they're available of course.  
1239 Mr. Examiner.  
1240 I too have additional cases on January 27th and I am fully prepared to move forward  
1241 and the division did send out the proposed contested hearing dates while in advance  
1242 of today so that we could be prepared to discuss hearing dates and we did that with  
1243 Yvonne and.  
1244 Yvonne is ready to move forward, so it be Avon strong preference to set the have a  
1245 pre hearing order issued for January 27th.  
1246 Got it.  
1247 So so Miss McLean, as you know, I do give preference to the applicator.

1248 Applicator to the.  
1249 To the applicant.  
1250 If for some reason your witnesses are just not available, please file a motion with an  
1251 affidavit showing us why we we would not be able to have it on the 27th and then  
1252 we might move it to. If it works for Miss Bennett, February 10, which is.  
1253 Not that far.  
1254 After it's less than two weeks after, or maybe two weeks after the January 27, but  
1255 we'll issue the pre hearing order and we'll wait to hear from Miss McLean if there is a  
1256 conflict.  
1257 With her witnesses, is there anything further, miss Bennett?  
1258 Nothing further.  
1259 Thank you.  
1260 Sounds good, miss McLean.  
1261 Nothing from Permian Resources M's Vance.
