APPLICATION

Coterra Energy Operating Co. (“Applicant”) (OGRID No. 215099), through its undersigned attorney, hereby files this Application with the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico (“Division”) requesting a one-year time extension to commence drilling the Well(s) authorized by Order No. R-23749 (“Order”). In support of its application, Applicant states the following:

1. The Division entered the Order in Case No. 24872 on April 1, 2025.
2. The Order pooled all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp Formation underlying a 1262.72 -acre, more or less, non-standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the Sections 30 and 31, both located in Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico (“Unit”), for the purpose of drilling the Speedmaster 30 Fed Com 006H (“006H Well”), Speedmaster 30 Fed Com 007H (“007H Well”), Speedmaster 30 Fed Com 008H (“008H Well”), and Speedmaster 30 Fed Com 009H (“009H Well”). The 006H Well, 007H Well, 008H Well, and 009H Well are referred to collectively herein as the “Wells.”
3. The Order designated Avant Operating, LLC (“Avant”) as operator of the Unit. In January 2025, Applicant acquired Avant’s interests in the Unit and is the successor in interest to Avant under the Order.

4. Paragraphs 28 and 29 of the Order require applicant to commence drilling the Wells within one (1) year of the date of the Order unless Applicant obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause shown.

5. Good cause exists for the requested extension.

6. This is Applicant's first request for extension under the Order.

7. Accordingly, Applicant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells until April 1, 2027.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing on March 5, 2026, and after notice and hearing, the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells under the Order until April 1, 2027.
