**NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S AGREED MOTION FOR
CONTINUANCE**

NOW COMES Movant, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), moves for an order continuing the hearing on the above Notice of Violation (“NOV”), and in support thereof, states:

1. The above-referenced matter is currently set for hearing on March 12, 2026.
2. Respondent, Burns Xpress, LLC, has requested to continue the hearing for at least a month, since Kenyon Burns of Respondent has stated that they are in the process of getting quotes to P&A the well that is subject of the NOV. Mr. Burns anticipated that the well could be plugged and abandoned within “a couple of months”. In the interest of administrative economy and operators taking responsibility for plugging and abandoning their own wells, OCD does not oppose a short continuance until the April 14, 2026 OCD docket. At that time Respondent should have more concrete and definite information to share with OCD relating the plugging of the subject well.
3. This continuance is not being sought for purposes of delay, but so that justice may be done. A proposed order is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Movant requests that this case be continued to the April 14, 2026 OCD docket.
