APPLICATION

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (“Chevron”) (OGRID No. 4323), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division for the limited purpose of amending Order R-23946 (the “Order”) to allow for an extension of time to complete the wells authorized by the Order. In support of this application, Chevron states:

1. The Order was issued on August 13, 2025, in Case No. 25332.
2. The Order designated Chevron as the operator and pooled all uncommitted interests in a standard 1920-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Sections 8, 17, and 20, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
3. The Order dedicated the following wells to the spacing unit: **Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 446H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 447H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 448H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 449H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 450H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 451H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 452H and Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 453H.**
4. Chevron spud the wells as follows:

5. For the wells that were spud on July 18, 2025, Chevron would be required to complete those wells by July 18, 2026. For the wells spud on September 29, 2025, Chevron would need to complete those wells by September 29, 2026.

6. Chevron requests that the deadline to complete the wells be extended for a year, to July 18, 2027 and September 29, 2027 respectively.

7. This is Chevron's first request for an extension of time. Chevron is seeking an extension of time through the administrative process set forth in paragraph 21 of the Order and is only filing this extension application out of abundance of caution.

8. If the administrative application is approved, Chevron will dismiss this application.

WHEREFORE, Chevron requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 2026 and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division amend the Order as set forth herein.

Applicant seeks an order from the Division amending Order R-23946 to extend the deadline to complete the wells under the Order. Order R-23946 pooled uncommitted interests within a 1920-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of Sections 8, 17, and 20, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Code 98220). The Order dedicated the following wells to the spacing unit: **Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 446H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 447H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 448H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 449H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 450H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 451H, Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 452H and Grey Goose 20 8 Federal Com 453H.** The unit is located approximately 10 miles southwest of Malaga, New Mexico.
