APPLICATION

Longfellow Energy, LP, OGRID No. 372210 (“Longfellow” or “Applicant”), through undersigned counsel, files this application with the Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) to extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-24036 (“Pooling Order”). In support of its application, Longfellow states:

1. On December 1, 2025, the Division entered Order No. 24036 in Case No. 25572, which pooled all uncommitted interests in the Yeso Formation underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico (“the Unit”), for the purposes of drilling the Petty Federal Com 31CD 001H (API No. *Pending*), Petty Federal Com 31CD 002H (API No. *Pending*), Petty Federal Com 31CD 003H (API No. 30-015-58413), Petty Federal Com 31CD 004H (API No. 30-015-58414), Petty Federal Com 31CD 005H (API No. 30-015-58420), Petty Federal Com 31CD 006H (API No. 30-015-58054), Petty Federal Com 31CD 007H (API No. 30-015-58421), Petty Federal Com 31CD 008H (API No. 30-015-58422), and the Petty Federal Com 31CD 009H (API No. *Pending*) wells (“the Wells”).
2. The Pooling Order designated Longfellow Energy, LP as the operator of the Unit.

3. Paragraphs 20 and 21 of the Pooling Order require Longfellow to commence drilling the Wells within one (1) year of the date of the Order unless Applicant obtains a time extension from the Division.

4. Good cause exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial Wells under the Pooling Order.

5. This is Applicant's first request for an extension under the Pooling Order.

6. Accordingly, Applicant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells to December 1, 2027.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing on August 6, 2026, and after notice and hearing, the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells under the Pooling Order to December 1, 2027.
