APPLICATION

Coterra Energy Operating Co. (“Coterra”) (OGRID No. 215099), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division for the limited purpose of amending Order R-23922 (the “Order”) to allow for an extension of time to commence drilling the wells authorized by the Order. In support of this application, Coterra states:

1. The Order was issued on August 13, 2025, in Case No. 25091.
2. Order R-23922 was issued to Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado. Coterra Energy Operating Co., an affiliate of Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado, is Cimarex’s successor in interest to the Order.
3. Order R-23922 pooled all uncommitted interests in a 1280-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Sections 28 and, 29, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Gas pool (Pool Code 98220).
4. The Order dedicated the **Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #9H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #10H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #11H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #12H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #13H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #14H, Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #15H and the Laguna Grande Fed Com 29-28 #16H** wells to the unit.

5. Under the Order, Coterra would be required to commence drilling the wells by August 13, 2026.

6. Coterra requests that the deadline to commence drilling the wells be extended for a year, to August 13, 2027.

7. This is Coterra's first request for an extension of time. Coterra is seeking an extension of time through the administrative process set forth in paragraph 21 of the Order and is only filing this extension application out of abundance of caution.

8. If the administrative application is approved, Coterra will dismiss this application.

WHEREFORE, Coterra requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 2026 and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order extending the time to commence drilling the wells under the Order until August 13, 2027.
