APPLICATION

Marathon Oil Permian, LLC (“Marathon” or “Applicant”), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend compulsory pooling Order No. R-23223 (“Order”) and add an additional mineral interest owner to the pooling order. In support of its application, Marathon states:

1. Division Order No. R-23223, entered on May 22, 2024, in Case No. 24150, created a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Sections 28 and 29, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”), and designated Marathon as operator of the Unit.

2. Order No. R-23223 further pooled the uncommitted mineral owners in the Bone Spring formation (Cass Draw; Bone Spring [10380]) in the Unit and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial **Magellan BS Fee #501H** (API No. 30-015-57453).

3. Applicant has discovered an additional mineral interest owner in the pooled acreage that was not subject to the pooling proceedings giving rise to Order R-23223.

4. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from the additional mineral interest owner.

5. WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as

required by law, the Division enter an order pooling the additional mineral interest owner under the Order.

CASE _____ : **Application of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC to Amend Order No. R-23223 to Add An Additional Pooled Party, Eddy County, New Mexico.** Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks to add an additional mineral interest owner to the pooling order. Order No. R-23223 in Case No. 24150 pooled uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Cass Draw; Bone Spring [10380]) underlying the S/2 of Sections 28 and 29, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 640-acre horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the proposed initial **Magellan BS Fee #501H** (API No. 30-015-57453), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 29, T22S-R27E, to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 28, T22S-R27E. Said area is located 3.5 miles southeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
