SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF LANDMAN KRISTINE PILGRIM

Kristine Pilgrim hereby states and declares:

1. My name is Kristine Pilgrim, and I am a landman for Burnett Oil Co., Inc., managing partner of Burnett Oil Company (“Burnett”). I am over 18 years of age, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein, and am competent to provide this Self-Affirmed Statement. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division and my credentials as an expert in petroleum land matters have been accepted as a matter of record.
2. I am submitting this self-affirmed statement in support of Burnett’s application in the above-referenced case pursuant to 19.15.14.12(A)(1) NMAC.
3. I am familiar with the application originally filed by Burnett in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to this application. Copies of Burnett’s Application and the Proposed Hearing Notice are attached as Burnett **Exhibit A-2**.
4. In this application, Burnett seeks an order amending Order No. R-23930 and R-23930-A (the “Order”) to allow for an extension of time to commence drilling the wells authorized by the Order.
5. The Division issued Order No. R-23930 in Case No. 25428 on September 8, 2025, and Order No. R-23930-A on November 26, 2025.

6. The Order pooled all uncommitted interests in the Yeso formation within a 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 Section 24 Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). A copy of the Order is attached as **Exhibit A-3**.

7. The Order designated Burnett as the operator of the Unit and the wells to be drilled within the Unit.

8. Paragraphs 20 and 21 of the Order require Burnett to commence drilling the initial well within one (1) year from the date of the Order unless Burnett obtains a time extension from the Division. Under the Order, the deadline to commence drilling the wells is September 8, 2026.

9. Burnett requests that the Order be re-opened and amended to allow Burnett additional time to commence drilling the wells under the Order.

10. Paragraph 21 of the Order provides that an extension is granted automatically if no objections have been filed within twenty (20) days by parties entitled to notice.

11. This is Burnett’s first request for an extension of time for the Order. Burnett is in good standing under the Division rules and regulations with respect to the Order.

12. Burnett requests an extension of time for one year from September 8, 2026 to September 8, 2027 to commence drilling the wells under the Order.

13. None of the working interest owners subject to the pooling order have been asked to make an election on the wells or to pay their estimated share of the costs to drill, complete, and equip the wells.

14. Burnett provided updated notice information, to the extent necessary, to Burnett’s counsel to provide notice of this extension application. None of the parties pooled by the Order

and noticed for this extension application have indicated opposition to this matter proceeding by affidavit, and therefore I do not expect any opposition at the hearing.

15. The exhibits to my self-affirmed statement were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction or supervision.

16. In my opinion, the granting of this application is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

17. I swear that to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the matters set forth herein and in the exhibits are true, correct, and accurate.

APPLICATION

Burnett Oil Company, Inc. ("Applicant") (OGRID No. 3080), through its undersigned attorney, hereby files this Application with the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico ("Division") requesting a one-year time extension to commence drilling the Well(s) authorized by Order No. R-23930 and R-23930-A (the "Orders"). In support of its application, Applicant states the following:

1. The Division entered Order No. R-23930 on September 8, 2025, and Order No. R-23930-A on November 26, 2025, adding additional owners to the original order, in Case No. 25428.
2. The Orders pooled all uncommitted interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying a 320 -acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the South-half (S/2) of Section 24, located in Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit"), for the purpose of drilling the Maverick Well No. 1H ("1H Well"), Maverick Well No. 2H ("2H Well"), and Maverick No. 3H ("3H Well"). The 1H Well, the 2H Well, and the 3H Well are referred to collectively herein as the "Wells."
3. The Order designated Burnett Oil Company, Inc. as operator of the Unit.
4. Paragraphs 20 and 21 of the Order require applicant to commence drilling the Wells within one (1) year of the date of the Order unless Applicant obtains a time extension from the Division Director.

5. This is Applicant's first request for extension under the Order.

6. Accordingly, Applicant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells until September 8, 2027.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this extension request be approved administratively if there is no objection. If required, Applicant requests this application be set for hearing on July 9, 2026, and after notice and hearing, the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells under the Order until September 8, 2027.

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on July 10, August 7, and September 11, 2025, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing and Technical Examiners, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Burnett Oil Company, Inc. (“Operator”) submitted an application (“Application”) to compulsory pool additional uncommitted owners of oil and gas interest under Order R-23930 and within the spacing unit described therein (“Unit”).
2. Subsequent to July 10, 2025, Operator requested that additional owners of interest in oil and gas minerals in the Unit (“Additional Owners”) be compulsory pooled.
3. Operator identified the Additional Owners and provided evidence that notice was given to each uncommitted owner.
4. OCD issued Order R-23930 on September 8, 2025. Order R-23930 pooled the uncommitted owners of oil and gas interest identified within the original application submitted to the Division on or about June 5, 2025.
5. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner on the date specified above, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
7. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.

8. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
9. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
10. The Additional Owners have not agreed to commit their interests to the Unit.
11. The pooling of Additional Owners will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
12. This Order affords to the Additional Owners of an uncommitted interest the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

ORDER

13. The Additional Owners are hereby pooled in the Unit.
14. Order R-23930 shall remain in full force and effect.
15. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on July 10 and August 7, 2025, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing and Technical Examiners, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Burnett Oil Company, Inc. (“Operator”) submitted an application (“Application”) to compulsory pool the uncommitted oil and gas interests within the spacing unit (“Unit”) described in Exhibit A. Operator seeks to be designated the operator of the Unit.
2. Operator will dedicate the well(s) described in Exhibit A (“Well(s)”) to the Unit.
3. Operator proposes the supervision and risk charges for the Well(s) described in Exhibit A.
4. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice was given.
5. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner on the date specified above, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
7. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.
8. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

9. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
10. Operator has the right to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply at the depth(s) and location(s) in the Unit described in Exhibit A.
11. The Unit contains separately owned uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals.
12. Some of the owners of the uncommitted interests have not agreed to commit their interests to the Unit.
13. The pooling of uncommitted interests in the Unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
14. This Order affords to the owner of an uncommitted interest the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

ORDER

15. The uncommitted interests in the Unit are pooled as set forth in Exhibit A.
16. The Unit shall be dedicated to the Well(s) set forth in Exhibit A.
17. Operator is designated as operator of the Unit and the Well(s).
18. If the location of a well will be unorthodox under the spacing rules in effect at the time of completion, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard location in accordance with 19.15.16.15(C) NMAC.
19. If the Unit is a non-standard horizontal spacing unit which has not been approved under this Order, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard horizontal spacing unit in accordance with 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC.
20. The Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.
21. This Order shall terminate automatically if the Operator fails to comply with the preceding paragraph unless the Operator requests an extension by notifying the OCD and all parties that required notice of the original compulsory pooling application in accordance with 19.15.4.12.B and 19.15.4.12.C NMAC. Upon no objection after twenty (20) days the extension is automatically granted up to one year. If a protest is received the extension is not granted and the Operator must set the case for a hearing.

22. Operator may propose reasonable deviations from the development plan via notice to the OCD and all parties that required notice of the original compulsory pooling application in accordance with 19.15.4.12.B and 19.15.4.12.C NMAC. Upon no objection after twenty (20) days the deviation is automatically granted. If a protest is received the deviation is not granted and the Operator must set the case for a hearing.
23. The infill well requirements in 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.12 NMAC shall be applicable.
24. Operator shall submit each owner of an uncommitted working interest in the pool ("Pooled Working Interest") an itemized schedule of estimated costs to drill, complete, and equip the well ("Estimated Well Costs").
25. No later than thirty (30) days after Operator submits the Estimated Well Costs, the owner of a Pooled Working Interest shall elect whether to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or its share of the actual costs to drill, complete and equip the well ("Actual Well Costs") out of production from the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who elects to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall render payment to Operator no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the election period, and shall be liable for operating costs, but not risk charges, for the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who fails to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or who elects to pay its share of the Actual Well Costs out of production from the well shall be considered to be a "Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest."
26. No later than one hundred eighty (180) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the Actual Well Costs. The Actual Well Costs shall be considered to be the Reasonable Well Costs unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Reasonable Well Costs after public notice and hearing.
27. No later than sixty (60) days after the expiration of the period to file a written objection to the Actual Well Costs or OCD's order determining the Reasonable Well Costs, whichever is later, each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall pay to Operator its share of the Reasonable Well Costs that exceed the Estimated Well Costs, or Operator shall pay to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Reasonable Well Costs.
28. The reasonable charges for supervision to drill and produce a well ("Supervision Charges") shall not exceed the rates specified in Exhibit A, provided however that the rates shall be

adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form entitled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."

29. No later than within ninety (90) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the reasonable charges for operating and maintaining the well ("Operating Charges"), provided however that Operating Charges shall not include the Reasonable Well Costs or Supervision Charges. The Operating Charges shall be considered final unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Operating Charges after public notice and hearing.
30. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs: (a) the proportionate share of the Supervision Charges; and (b) the proportionate share of the Operating Charges.
31. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest: (a) the proportionate share of the Reasonable Well Costs; (b) the proportionate share of the Supervision and Operating Charges; and (c) the percentage of the Reasonable Well Costs specified as the charge for risk described in Exhibit A.
32. Operator shall distribute a proportionate share of the costs and charges withheld pursuant to the preceding paragraph to each Pooled Working Interest that paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs.
33. Each year on the anniversary of this Order, and no later than ninety (90) days after each payout, Operator shall provide to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest a schedule of the revenue attributable to a well and the Supervision and Operating Costs charged against that revenue.
34. Any cost or charge that is paid out of production shall be withheld only from the share due to an owner of a Pooled Working Interest. No cost or charge shall be withheld from the share due to an owner of a royalty interests. For the purpose of this Order, an unleased mineral interest shall consist of a seven-eighths (7/8) working interest and a one-eighth (1/8) royalty interest.
35. Except as provided above, Operator shall hold the revenue attributable to a well that is not disbursed for any reason for the account of the person(s) entitled to the revenue as provided in the Oil and Gas Proceeds Payment Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 70-10-1 et seq., and relinquish

such revenue as provided in the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 7-8A-1 et seq.

36. The Unit shall terminate if (a) the owners of all Pooled Working Interests reach a voluntary agreement; or (b) the well(s) drilled on the Unit are plugged and abandoned in accordance with the applicable rules. Operator shall inform OCD no later than thirty (30) days after such occurrence.
37. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.

Enclosed is a copy of an application filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division by Burnett, requesting the following relief:

Application of Burnett Oil Company, Inc. to Extend Time to Commence Drilling Operations, Eddy County, New Mexico. Burnett Oil Company, Inc. (“Applicant”) seeks an order extending the deadline to commence drilling the wells authorized by Order Nos. R-23930 and R-23930-A (collectively “the Order”), by one year to September 8, 2027. The Division entered Order No. R-23930 on September 8, 2025, and R-23930-A on November 26, 2025, in Case No. 25428. The Order pooled all uncommitted interests in the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the South-half (S/2) of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”), for the purpose of drilling the Maverick Well No. 1H (“1H Well”), Maverick Well No. 2H (“2H Well”), and Maverick No. 3H (“3H Well”).
