12 Good morning, Mr. Holly.

13 Are you ready to start?

14 Sorry, I didn't hear you.

15
16 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 7:14**

17 Apologize. Yes, I'm ready.

18
19 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 7:15**

20 All right.

21 Sounds good.

22 This is the Nov docket notices, a violation docket that the Oil Conservation Division
23 conducts once a month.

24 It is a special docket.

25 My name is Gregory Chakai and I'm the hearing officer with me today. We have
26 Michael Hall of the office of General Counsel and we have Mada E Corral.

27 Who is the hearing clerk? We have a 10 item docket one item.

28 Item has been dismissed this morning based on a filing that I received a few minutes
29 ago.

30 That is item number 4.

31 So we're not gonna hear item number 4 today.

32 Let's start out with item number one.

33 This is the oil conservation division versus respondent Colthurst management.

34 This is case 25940 entries of appearance please.

35

3 MS **Miguel Suazo** 8:06

37 Yes. Good morning Mr. Examiner.

38

3 HE **Hall, Michael, EMNRD** 8:06

40 But yet.

41

4 MS **Miguel Suazo** 8:08

43 Miguel Suazo with beating Wozniak, appearing on behalf of Colther.

44 Sorry, Mr. Hall. I didn't mean to go 1st and cut you off.

45

4 HE **Hall, Michael, EMNRD** 8:13

47 No, not not at all.

48 Not a problem.

49 Yes, Michael Hall here, on behalf of the Oil Conservation Division, I'm ready to
50 proceed.

51

5 CE **Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD** 8:22

53 OK.

54 Good morning. Both of you, Mr. Suazo.

55 This case was on the docket last month.

56 What have what has happened since then?

57

5 MS **Miguel Suazo** 8:32

59 Well, I I have to report this morning that the Erin wells remain out of compliance and
60 that the current operator remains responsible unless and until OCD approves a
61 transfer.

62 So you know, for purposes of the record and for the division zone background
63 information, COLTHORSE has continued to to actively pursue a transaction with a
64 company called Wetlander to raise the capital and capacity that they need to return
65 various wells to production.

66 As you know, BLM has granted an extension to December 1st of this year for them to
67 complete that work.

68 So they've reached an agreement in principle that nothing's been signed. It seems
69 like they've raised about 40 to 60% of the capital required to do the work that they're

70 anticipating.
71 But they still haven't been able to sign the transfer paperwork and get that submitted
72 to OCD, so I'm not here to represent that, you know, it's complete or imminent or
73 that it's guaranteed, but it still remains contingent upon them securing their
74 remaining financing.
75 It sounds to me like the parties are working as fast as they can.
76 It's just their timetable does not, you know, is not doesn't overlap with today's
77 proceedings.
78 So we're going to tell you where things stand, but unfortunately we're not in a
79 position to represent to the division that we're in compliance or will be in the near
80 term.

8 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 9:52**

83 Thank you, Mr. Hall.

84

8 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 9:55**

86 Yes, that that Mister Suazo essentially told me the same thing I heard you last time
87 say.

88 That was the last continuance, so.

89 To proceed. That being said, I told Mr. Suazo that.

90 That that in the event they wanna bring these wells into production at some time in
91 the future or have a plan for plugging in abandonment to the extent OCD is able to
92 to work with them on that. That's our goal and and to bring these into compliance.

93 And and I believe we agreed on a civil penalty last time too.

94 So so honestly, I would just offer exhibits 1.

95 2-3 and four and ask for the reduced civil penalty.

9 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 10:41**

98 OK, Mr. Suazo. Any objection to that?

99

10 **MS Miguel Suazo 10:45**

101 No, Mr. Zaman or no objection.

102

10 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 10:47**

104 OK, exhibits admitted without exception.

105 So Mr. Hall? Well, first, let me ask you, Mr. Suazo, do you have any evidence you
106 want to enter into the record?

107

108 **MS Miguel Suazo 11:00**

109 I do not have any evidence to turn to the record at this time.

110 I'm not sure what I would submit even if you know the deal was closed, other than
111 probably a redacted version of the agreement. If it's non confidential and maybe any
112 paperwork that they intend to submit.

113 So at this point, you know, I think we're just going to have to accept the civil penalty,
114 we're going to continue working with Mr. Hall on a compliance order.

115 I know that Mister Mr. Colherth wants to have this be the last thing he does in his
116 career that ends well.

117 So that's what he's represented to me, and I wish him, you know, all the best in in
118 achieving that.

119 And we'll help him do it where we can.

120 But you know he has till December 1st at the latest at this point and I hope that he
121 doesn't saddle the taxpayer with these obligations and it seems to me like he's trying
122 not to do that.

123 It's just not in time for today's proceedings.

124

125 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 11:51**

126 Thank you, Mr. Spazzo.

127 Mr. Hall, anything further.

128

129 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 11:55**

130 No, I just wanted to announce for purposes of the record, I believe our agreement
131 was \$1000 on the civil penalty and that that's that's all from OCD.

132

133 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 12:06**

134 OK. And when should we expect a proposed order?

135

136 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 12:10**

137 I told Mr. Suazo if he'd like to, I can send him kind of the form and let him look at it.

138 Shouldn't. Hopefully I'm going to be on vacation's on the issue, so I have a little time

139 tomorrow blocked out to hopefully do that, but it may be it may be a couple weeks if
140 I can't get it done before vacation so.

141

142 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 12:31**

143 OK, so before the next, are we gonna have a a special docket in August?

144

145 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 12:35**

146 It doesn't seem like it and and I I'm happy to talk to you more logistics later, but
147 that's.

148

149 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 12:37**

150 OK.

151 All right.

152

153 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 12:44**

154 I I have a couple of cases that I've and if things need to be continued or pushed out, I
155 think there's maybe a September 3rd docket and that's don't quote me on that.

156

157 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 12:45**

158 OK.

159

160 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 12:54**

161 But Freya gave me a date and it's not a special docket.

162 So there may be a couple of matters I had to amend one and it's on there, so.

163

164 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 12:59**

165 OK.

166

167 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:04**

168 But as far as a special docket?

169

170 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:04**

171 OK.

172

173 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:06**

174 I haven't heard that yet, nor do I have the volume of novs at this time for that.

175

176 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:09**

177 Perfect.

178

179 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:10**

180 Yeah.

181

182 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:11**

183 OK. All right.

184 All right.

185 So you want to say a month from now for this proposed order after you pass it by?

186

187 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:19**

188 Sure. And I'll I will try to have them tomorrow, but yeah, a month, a month, a month
189 is probably more reasonable.

190

191 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:23**

192 Fine.

193 OK.

194 Very good.

195 All right, we're off the record in this case.

196 Thank you, Mr. Suazo.

197

198 **MS Miguel Suazo 13:31**

199 Thank you.

200

201 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:32**

202 Thank you.

203

204 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:32**

205 Let's move on to case number 2. On the docket 26197.

206 This is the oil conservation division versus respondent Joseph Sanchez.

207

208 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 13:41**

209 Yes, OCD is ready.

210 We've been in touch with Mr. Sanchez and essentially have an agreement.

211 It did not come in the form of an SFO, but I want to announce that he has filed the
212 proper paperwork to memorialize the the plugging and abandonment of the well
213 that's been approved.

214

215 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 13:50**

216 Yeah.

217 So.

218

219 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:02**

220 He has also agreed, and I've sent him the address and payee for.

221 \$100 civil penalty so.

222

223 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 14:09**

224 OK.

225 Well, do you want to enter evidence into the record?

226

227 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:14**

228 Yeah, I would, I would.

229 I would like to offer OC DS exhibits 123 and four attached to our pre hearing
230 statement.

231

232 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 14:21**

233 All right. Do we have anyone from Joseph Sanchez doing business as JNF
234 production?

235 I don't believe anyone's here. Did they know of today's hearing?

236

237 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:34**

238 Yes, but he he he's not in the oil.

239

240 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 14:35**

241 OK.

242

243 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:38**

244 He's a trucker who who ended up kind of with this well, is my understanding. And
245 also he's had a hard time kind of dealing with things electronically.

246

247 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 14:39**

248 OK.

249 OK.

250

251 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:49**

252 I'm not trying to cast aspersions on him, but that's what he's told me. So. So it's not
253 surprising he's not here.

254

255 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 14:52**

256 Right.

257

258 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 14:55**

259 However, I have announced our agreement and he did.

260 He did take care of the noncompliance.

261

262 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:00**

263 Perfect. So your exhibits are admitted without exception and you have a agreement.

264 It sounds like and you'll have the director.

265

266 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:03**

267 Thank you.

268

269 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:10**

270 Sign that and then file a motion to dismiss.

271

272 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:13**

273 Not in this case.

274

275 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:13**

276 No, no.

277

278 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:14**

279 In this case, we're we're just gonna enter an order instead of an SFO.

280

281 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:18**

282 Oh.

283

284 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:18**

285 Which it will memorialize the fact that he has now done the proper reporting. He had
286 not at the time, and that the civil penalty is \$100.

287

288 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:30**

289 So will this case be dismissed?

290

291 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:33**

292 I will be a final order in this case that would that will operate operate to to end the
293 Nov process. I guess is how I same as any other final order.

294

295 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:36**

296 Will be.

297 OK.

298 So then you'll you'll submit a proposed order.

299

300 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:48**

301 Correct. Yes, Sir. Yes, Sir.

302

303 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 15:49**

304 In a month. OK, very good.

305 We'll we'll just set the one month since you're going on vacation, we'll set a one
306 month deadline for any orders proposed orders.

307

308 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 15:55**

309 OK.

310

311 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:00**

312 In this docket. OK, perfect.

313

314 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:02**

315 Sounds good.

316

317 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:02**

318 Then we're off the we're off the record. In that case, let's move on to case number
319 three on the docket. This is case 26198. Oil conservation division versus Respondent
320 John Mccool.

321

322 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:15**

323 OCD is present and ready.

324

325 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:16**

326 Thank you.

327 Do we have anyone from John Mccool?

328

329 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:24**

330 I have been in touch with someone from John Mccool.

331

332 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:25**

333 OK.

334

335 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:28**

336 They have not exactly addressed a plan to bring these wells into compliance.

337 They are blaming a past transaction which was not memorialized in AC145.

338

339 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:37**

340 Hmm.

341 OK.

342

343 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:41**

344 So we're we're ready to proceed.

345

346 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:44**

347 Go right ahead.

348

349 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:45**

350 On this matter, OK, we would offer exhibits 123 and four.

351

352 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 16:49**

353 Any objection?

354 Not hearing any.

355 They're admitted without exception.

356 How do you want to proceed in this default proceeding?

357

358 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 16:57**

359 Would ask to draft an order.

360

361 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 17:00**

362 OK.

363

364 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 17:01**

365 Commensurate with our pleadings in this matter.

366

367 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 17:04**

368 OK.

369 How much is the fine in this case?

370

371 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 17:07**

372 I'll have to let me pull this one up, Mr. hearing examiner.

373

374 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 17:10**

375 Sure.

376

377 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 17:11**

378 I had a couple other ones pulled up and I don't have this one yet.

379 It looks like it's won well, so \$450.

380

381 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 17:23**

382 All right.

383 Anything else?

384

385 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 17:26**

386 Nothing from OCD.

387

388 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 17:28**

389 Alright, thank you.

390 We're off the record.

391 In that case, I have dismissed case number four, so we're not gonna hear that case.

392 Let's go to case #5.

393 This is 26200 oil Conservation division versus Respondent J Cooper Enterprises.

394 Entries please.

395

396 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 17:46**

397 Yes, Maquoha on behalf of OCD, we do have an agreement which is in the process of
398 becoming an executed SFO. It has been executed by the operator, I believe.

399 We're waiting on the director signature on that.

400 That's another case where we've agreed on a small civil penalty.

401 It was one, well, an injection.

402 Well, they have now filed all the C115's which they had not, which brings the well
403 into compliance. Once those are accepted.

404

405 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 18:14**

406 All right, perfect, Mr. Hall.

407 Thank you.

408 We're so then at some point we'll get a motion to dismiss, OK?

409

410 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 18:21**

411 Correct. Yes, Sir.

412

413 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 18:21**

414 All right, perfect.

415 Thank you.
416 We're off the record in case #5. Let's go to case number 626201. Oil conservation
417 division versus respondent general minerals.

418

419 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 18:33**

420 OCD is present and ready to proceed.

421

422 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 18:35**

423 OK. And do we have anyone from general minerals?

424 Have you been in touch with anyone, Mr. Hall?

425

426 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 18:43**

427 I have not been in touch with this operator.

428

429 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 18:45**

430 OK.

431 All right.

432 How do you want to proceed?

433

434 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 18:48**

435 We we would like to offer OCD exhibits 123 and four and proceed under a default.

436

437 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 18:59**

438 OK.

439 So those are all admitted without exception.

440 OK.

441 So then there'll be a proposed order here.

442

443 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 19:07**

444 Correct. And just for the record of the civil penalty, we will request given that's nine
445 wells is \$4050.

446

447 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 19:15**

448 Alright, OK.

449 Very good.

450 Thank you, Mr. Hall.

451 We're off the record.

452

453 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 19:18**

454 Thank you.

455

456 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 19:18**

457 In that case, let's move on to case #7 on the docket 26300 Oil Conservation Division
458 versus LG and S oil company respondent.

459

460 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 19:30**

461 OCD is present and ready to proceed.

462

463 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 19:32**

464 Thank you, Mr. Hall.

465 Do we have anyone from LGNS?

466 Have you been in touch with anyone?

467

468 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 19:38**

469 I have not.

470 Not to the best of my recollection.

471

472 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 19:40**

473 No.

474 All right.

475 How do you want to proceed?

476

477 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 19:45**

478 Proceed. We would offer exhibits 123 and four attached to our pre hearing
479 statement.

480 And proceed under default, seeking the remedy sought out in our pleadings.

481 Namely, oh, sorry, go ahead.

482

483 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 19:57**

484 They're admitted.

485 They're admitted without exception.

486 And will you be drafting a proposed order?

487

488 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 20:03**

489 I will.

490 It's a \$900 civil penalty in this matter will be requesting.

491

492 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 20:08**

493 Alright, perfect.

494 Thank you.

495 We're off the record.

496 In that case, let's move on to case #8 on the docket.

497 This is case 26301 oil Conservation division versus respondent La Plata gathering
498 system.

499

500 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 20:23**

501 OCD's president and ready to proceed.

502

503 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 20:25**

504 OK. Do we have anyone from La Plata?

505

506 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 20:30**

507 Nor have I heard from anyone.

508

509 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 20:31**

510 Mr. Hall.

511 You have not heard.

512

513 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 20:34**

514 No, I haven't.

515 And these that when when an e-mail or a certified mail went through, I'd I'd leave it
516 at that.

517 But sometimes it it's either unknown or it appears it might not have.

518

519 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 20:41**

520 Right.

521

522 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 20:46**

523 I reached out on this docket.

524 I've reached out and called those people and I have not on the number provided to

525 OCD on their operator page, and I have not received a response.

526 I believe Laplata might be one of those, but generally for every case on this docket

527 that's that's the step I took kind of above and beyond.

528

529 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 20:58**

530 OK.

531 Proposed order Mr. Hall.

532

533 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:09**

534 Yes. And we would offer exhibits 123 and four.

535

536 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:13**

537 They've already been admitted.

538 Well, I thought they'd been.

539

540 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:14**

541 Oh well, I apologize.

542

543 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:15**

544 Maybe they hadn't been admitted.

545

546 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:16**

547 I don't if in abundance of caution ioffer those exhibits so.

548

549 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:20**

550 Yes.

551 And in abundance of caution, we accept them into evidence without exception, of

552 course, and proposed order.

553

554 **HE** Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:24

555 Thank you.

556

557 **CE** Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:27

558 Mr. Hall, OK.

559

560 **HE** Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:28

561 Yes, and it'll be \$900 civil penalty in this one.

562

563 **CE** Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:33

564 Very good.

565 We're off the record in case #8. Let's move to case number 926302, Oil Conservation

566 Division versus respondent kimlar oil company.

567

568 **HE** Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:45

569 OCD's president ready to proceed?

570

571 **CE** Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 21:47

572 Thank you.

573 Do we have anyone from kimlar oil?

574 Mr. Hall.

575

576 **HE** Hall, Michael, EMNRD 21:52

577 No, I have not been in touch this.

578 This is when I'm positive I reached out to a lady named Becky Hills. I got.

579

580 **CE** Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:00

581 OK.

582

583 **HE** Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:01

584 I got a even got a voicemail on one of the numbers.

585 I believe it was a cell.

586 I don't remember which number couple of numbers.

587 I left a voicemail so and no response.

588

589 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:12**

590 Alright, how do you want to proceed?

591

592 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:16**

593 We would precede by offering OC DS exhibits 123 and four.

594

595 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:21**

596 OK, admitted without exception.

597 Are you going to draft a proposed order?

598

599 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:24**

600 Yes, and the civil penalty is was four wells.

601

602 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:25**

603 Perfect.

604

605 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:27**

606 I believe so.

607 1800 is what we request.

608

609 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:30**

610 Very good.

611 And finally, we have case. We're off the record.

612 In that case, let's go on to case number 1026304, oil Conservation division versus
613 respondent Keystone exploration.

615 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:45**

616 OCD is present and ready to proceed.

617

618 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 22:48**

619 Do we have anyone from Keystone with us?

620 Not hearing anyone, Mr. Hall.

621

622 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 22:54**

623 I have not.

624 I have not been able to.

625 Communicate with anyone from Keystone.

626

627 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 23:01**

628 All right.

629 How do you want to proceed?

630

631 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 23:03**

632 Well, we would proceed by offering exhibits 123 and four attached to OC DS pre
633 hearing statement.

634

635 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 23:09**

636 Admitted, without exception, proposed order.

637

638 **HE Hall, Michael, EMNRD 23:12**

639 Thank you.

640 Yes, one more else \$450 civil penalty and other relief sought out in our pleadings.

641

642 **CE Chakalian, Gregory, EMNRD 23:20**

643 Very good. OK.

644 That's it for today's docket. And Mr. Hall, if you don't have enough cases in the next

660 even coordinate with Freya if we had to have another volume to get another special
661 docket date set for these. So. So we're gonna keep. We're gonna keep pressing on

665 Perfect.

666 By all means.

667 That sounds wonderful, Mr. Hall.
