CONSOLIDATED PRE-HEARING STATEMENT

Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian Resources or “Applicant”) submits its Consolidated Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

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STATEMENT OF THE CASES

In **Case No. 26238**, Permian Resources seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 1,280.11-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of Sections 33 and 34, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This unit will be dedicated to the **Gabagool Fed Com 112H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 33 to a last take point in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 34. The completed interval of the Gabagool Fed Com 112H well will be located within 330' of the half-section line separating N/2 and S/2 of Sections 33 and 34 to allow for the creation of a 1,280.11-acre, standard horizontal spacing unit.

In **Case No. 26239**, Permian Resources seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 640.11-acre, more or less, non-standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Sections 33 and 34, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This unit will be dedicated to the following wells: **Gabagool Fed Com 2H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 33 to a last take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 34; and **Gabagool Fed Com 122H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 33 to a last take point in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 34.

In **Case No. 26240**, Permian Resources seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 640-acre, more or less, non-standard horizontal spacing

unit comprised of the S/2 of Sections 33 and 34, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This unit will be dedicated to the following wells: **Gabagool Fed Com 221H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 33 to a last take point in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 34; and **Gabagool Fed Com 222H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 33 to a last take point in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 34.

Permian Resources requests approval of non-standard horizontal spacing units in Case Nos. 26239 and 26240 pursuant to Rule 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC, which will create cost efficiencies, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

The completed intervals of the Gabagool wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells, the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as operator of the units and the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
