WPX Energy Permian, LLC (“WPX”), OGRID No. 246289, through its undersigned attorneys, submits the following Prehearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division (“Division”).

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APPLICANT’S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. 26318, WPX seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying a standard 769.91-acre, more or less, spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Sections 23, 26 and 35, Township 26 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

WPX Proposes the **Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 321H Well, Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 322H Well, Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 331H Well, and the Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 332H Well**, as initial wells, to be drilled to a sufficient depth to test the Bone Spring formation.

The **Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 321H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 4 of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 23.

The **Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 322H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 4 of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 23.

The **Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 331H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 4 of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 23.

The **Ross Draw 35-26-23 Fed Com 332H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 4 of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 23.

All the wells proposed herein are orthodox in their locations, as take points and completed intervals will comply with setback requirements under statewide rules.
