**APPLICATION**

Permian Resources Operating, LLC (“Permian” or “Applicant”), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to (1) extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-23089 (“Pooling Order”), as amended, and (2) remove a well included in the original Pooling Order. In support of its application, Permian states:

1. On April 1, 2025, the Division entered Order No. R-23089-A in Case No. 23508, which pooled the uncommitted interests underlying a 320.21-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of Lot 4 (NW/4 NW/4 equivalent), SW/4 NW/4, and W/2 SW/4 of irregular Section 4 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). Order No. R-23089-A designated Permian as operator and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial **Bane 4 Fed Com 111H** (API No. 30-025-56106), **Bane 4 Fed Com 121H** (API No. 30-025-56085), **Bane 4 Fed Com 122H** (API No. 30-025-56086), **Bane 4 Fed Com 171H** (API No. 30-025-56098), and **Bane 4 Fed Com 131H** (API No. 30-025-56094) wells.

2. Case No. 23508 was subject to a *de novo* hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission (“Commission”). Commission Order R-24080 reaffirmed the granting of Permian’s

application and was entered on October 16, 2025, and took effect on November 5, 2025. *See* Commission Order R-24080, Ordering (d).

3. Good cause exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial wells under the Pooling Order. Specifically, Permian requests a one-year extension for the **Bane 4 Fed Com 111H**, **Bane 4 Fed Com 121H**, and **Bane 4 Fed Com 122H** wells. The **Bane 4 Fed Com 131H** well is currently being drilled, therefore an extension is not needed because drilling has commenced prior to the November 5, 2026 drilling deadline.

4. Additionally, Permian requests to amend the Pooling Order and remove the **Bane 4 Fed Com 171H** from the Pooling Order.

5. Under the Pooling Order, Applicant would be required to commence drilling the wells by November 5, 2026, and therefore, asks for the deadline to commence drilling the wells be extended for a year, to November 5, 2027.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 3, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order extending the time for Permian to commence drilling the proposed initial wells under the Order and remove the Bane 4 Fed Com 171H from the original Pooling Order.

CASE \_\_\_\_\_: **Application of Permian Resources Operating, LLC to Extend the Drilling Deadline and Amend the Initial Wells Included Under Order No. R-23089, As Amended, Lea County, New Mexico.** Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks to (1) extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-23089 ("Pooling Order"), as amended, and (2) remove a well included in the original Pooling Order. Order No. R-23089-A, in Case No. 23508, pooled the uncommitted interests underlying a 320.21-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of Lot 4 (NW/4 NW/4 equivalent), SW/4 NW/4, and W/2 SW/4 of irregular Section 4 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Order No. R-23089-A designated Permian as operator and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial **Bane 4 Fed Com 111H** (API No. 30-025-56106), **Bane 4 Fed Com 121H** (API No. 30-025-56085), **Bane 4 Fed Com 122H** (API No. 30-025-56086), **Bane 4 Fed Com 171H** (API No. 30-025-56098), and **Bane 4 Fed Com 131H** (API No. 30-025-56094) wells, all to be drilled from surface hole locations in Lot 4 (NW/4 NW/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 4, first take points in Lot 4 (NW/4 NW/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 4, and last take points in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 9. Permian specifically requests a one-year extension for the **Bane 4 Fed Com 111H**, **Bane 4 Fed Com 121H**, and **Bane 4 Fed Com 122H** wells and to remove the **Bane 4 Fed Com 171H** from the Pooling Order. Said area is located approximately 27 miles southwest of Hobbs, New Mexico.
