APPLICATION

COG Operating LLC (“COG” or “Applicant”) (OGRID No. 229137), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order (a) approving a standard 959.23-acre, more or less, overlapping horizontal well spacing unit in a portion of the Bone Spring formation comprised of Lots 1-2, S/2 NE/4 and the SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and the E/2 of Sections 11 and 14, Township 23 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (b) pooling the uncommitted interests therein. In support of this application, COG states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed overlapping horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the proposed **Redtail Federal Com 403H** well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 of irregular Section 2, with a first take point in Lot 1 (NE/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and last take point in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 14.
3. The completed interval of the **Redtail Federal Com 403H** well is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow

4. This horizontal well spacing unit will overlap the following existing Bone Spring spacing units:

- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado's Cuervo Federal 20H (API: 30-025-40559);
- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado's Cuervo Federal 26H (API: 30-025-42094);
- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado's Cuervo Federal 21H (API: 30-025-41495);
- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the Lot 1, SE/4 NE/4 and the E/2 SE/4 (E/2 E/2 equivalent) of Section 2, dedicated to COG Operating LLC's Redtail State 1H (API: 30-025-40181); and
- 640-acre horizontal wells spacing unit comprised of the W2 E2 of Sections 2, 11, and 14 dedicated COG Operating LLC Redtail Federal Com #602H (API: 30-025-53389).

5. An ownership depth severance exists in the Bone Spring formation, within the proposed horizontal well spacing unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool only the First Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation, defined as the stratigraphic equivalent of between 9,925 feet and 10,551 feet total vertical depth, as seen in the Triste Draw Federal #2 (API 30-025-27708). COG will provide notice of this hearing to the vertical offset parties within the pool who are not subject to this pooling application.

6. Applicant has reached a voluntary agreement with all working interest owners in this proposed unit but seeks a pooling order for certain non-cost-bearing interest owners, including

overriding royalty interest owners and record title owners, who have yet to execute the necessary federal and state communitization agreements.

7. The pooling of the uncommitted interest owners will allow Applicant to obtain a just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 6, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Approving the overlapping horizontal well spacing unit and pooling certain overriding royalty interest owners and record title owners in the proposed overlapping horizontal well spacing unit; and
- B. Designating Applicant as the operator of this spacing unit and the horizontal well to be drilled thereon.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF JESS RITTER

1. My name is Jess Ritter and I am a Landman with COG Operating LLC (“COG”), now a wholly-owned subsidiary of ConocoPhillips Company.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by COG in this case and the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. In **Case No. 26373**, COG seeks an order (a) approval of a standard 959.23-acre, more or less, overlapping horizontal well spacing unit in a portion of the Bone Spring formation comprised of Lots 1-2, S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and the E/2 of Sections 11 and 14, Township 23 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (b) pooling the uncommitted interests therein. COG seeks to initially dedicate this Bone Spring spacing unit to the proposed **Redtail Federal Com 403H** (API No. 30-025-56445) well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 of irregular Section 2, with a first take point in Lot 1 (NE/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and last take point in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 14.

The completed interval of the **Redtail Federal Com 403H** well is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing unit under 19.15.16.15.B(3)(b) NMAC.

6. An ownership depth severance exists in the Bone Spring formation, within the proposed horizontal well spacing unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool only the First Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation, defined as the stratigraphic equivalent of between 9,925 feet and 10,551 feet total vertical depth, as seen in the Triste Draw Federal #2 (API 30-025 27708).

7. This horizontal well spacing unit will overlap the following existing Bone Spring spacing units:

- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Coterra Energy Operating Co.'s Cuervo Federal 20H (API: 30-025 40559);
- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Coterra Energy Operating Co.'s Cuervo Federal 26H (API: 30-025 42094);
- 160-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 14, dedicated to Coterra Energy Operating Co.'s Cuervo Federal 21H (API: 30-025 41495);
- 159.61-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lot 1, SE/4 NE/4 and the E/2 SE/4 (E/2 E/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2, dedicated to COG Operating LLC's Redtail State Com 1H (API: 30-025-40181); and
- 959.23-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lots 1-2, S/2 NE/4 and SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2, and E/2 of Sections 11 and 14, dedicated COG Operating LLC's Redtail Federal Com 602H (API: 30-025-53389).

8. **COG Exhibit C-1** includes a diagram depicting the newly proposed spacing unit in relation to the existing spacing units. COG identified a scrivener error in its application related

to the legal land description for the overlaps; therefore, COG will seek approval of the overlapping spacing unit separately.

9. **COG Exhibit C-2** contains the C-102s for the proposed well. This form demonstrates that the completed interval for the well will comply with statewide setbacks for oil wells. COG understands that this Bone Spring well will be placed in the Red Tank; Bone Spring [51683] and Diamondtail; Bone Spring [17644].

10. **COG Exhibit C-3** identifies the tracts of land comprising the horizontal spacing unit, the ownership interests in each tract, and ownership interests on a spacing unit basis. The parties COG seeks to pool are highlighted in yellow. The subject acreage is comprised of state and federal lands.

11. COG owns 100% of the operating rights in this proposed unit but seeks a pooling order for certain non-cost-bearing interest owners, including overriding royalty interest owners and record title owners, who have yet to execute the necessary federal and state communitization agreements. The parties that COG seeks to pool are highlighted in yellow in Exhibit C-3.

12. **COG Exhibit C-4** is a chronology of contacts, which reflects a summary of my efforts to locate and communicate with each of the parties that COG seeks to pool. In my opinion, COG has undertaken good-faith, diligent effort to locate and reach an agreement with each interest owner. The exhibit also includes the commitment status and, if applicable, type of commitment for each interest owner.

13. Because the interest COG seeks to pool are non-cost bearing interests, COG is not requesting to assess a proportionate share of costs, risk charges, or overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed well.

14. COG has provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP with the names and addresses of the parties COG seeks to pool. In providing names and addresses, COG has examined the county records, conducted computer searches and engaged in other good faith efforts to locate the most recent addresses for all of the parties that it seeks to pool.

15. **COG Exhibit C-1 and C-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision, or contain company business records.

16. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.

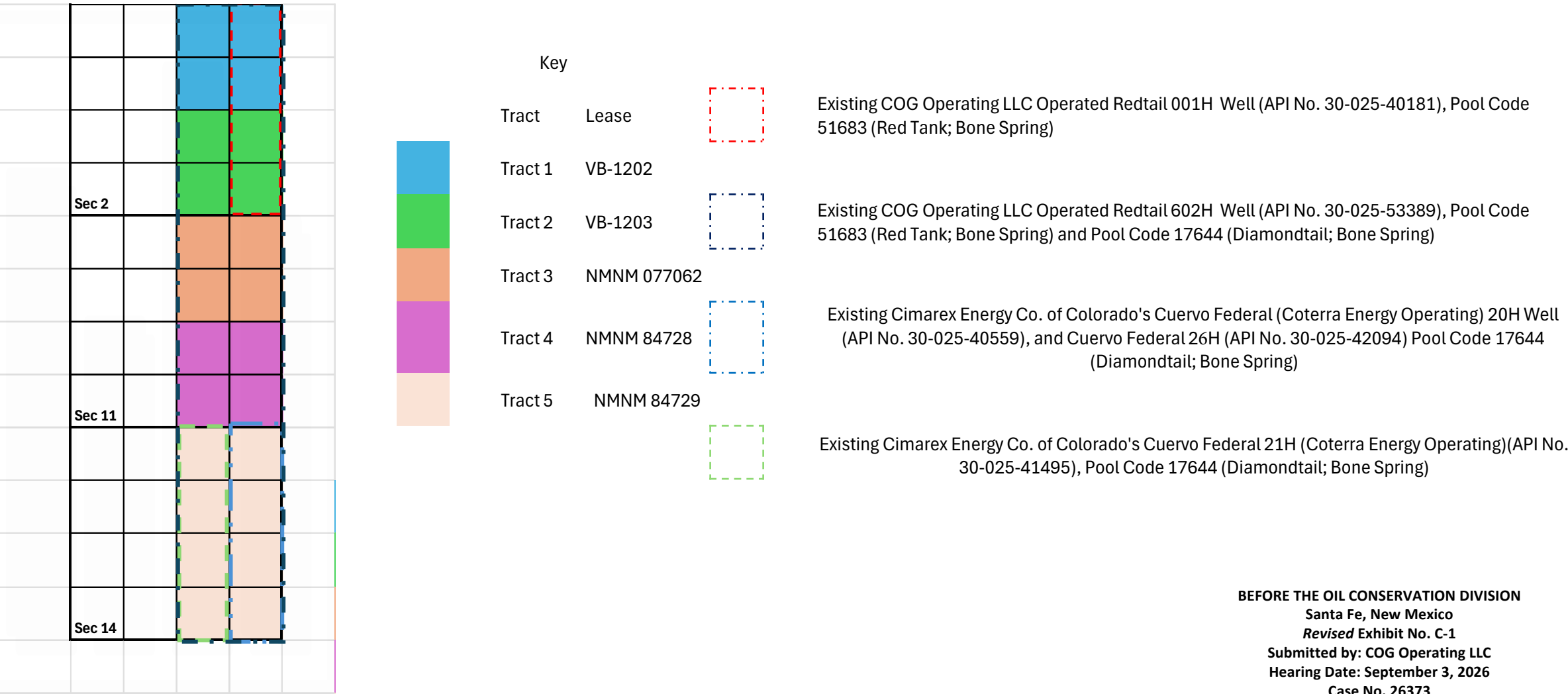

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF BEN BREYMAN

1. My name is Ben Breyman and I am a Senior Geologist with COG Operating LLC (“COG”), now a wholly-owned subsidiary of ConocoPhillips Company.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum geology. My credentials as a petroleum geologist have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by COG in this case and have conducted a geologic study of lands in the subject area.

4. **COG Exhibit D-1** is a locator map depicting COG’s acreage in yellow for the Bone Spring formation within the proposed spacing unit. Existing producing Bone Spring formation wells in the First Bone Spring intervals, which is the interval targeted by COG’s proposed initial well, are represented by solid lines. The approximate wellbore path for the proposed initial well is within this interval and depicted with dashed lines.

5. **COG Exhibit D-2** is a subsea structure map that I prepared for the top of the Bone Spring that is representative of the targeted interval within the Bone Spring formation. The data points are indicated by the red and purple circles. The approximate wellbore path for the proposed initial well is again depicted with dashed lines. This map shows that the formation is gently dipping

to the southeast in this area. I do not observe any faulting, pinchouts, or other geologic impediments to developing the targeted interval with horizontal wells in this area.

6. **COG Exhibit D-3** overlays a cross-section line consisting of two wells penetrating the Bone Spring formation that I used to construct a stratigraphic cross section from A to A'. I chose the logs from these wells to create the cross-section because they penetrate the targeted interval, are of good quality and have been subjected to petrophysical analysis of the targeted intervals. In my opinion, these well logs are representative of the geology in the subject area.

7. On the left-hand side of **COG Exhibit D-4** is a stratigraphic cross-section using the representative wells depicted in COG Exhibit D-3. Each well in the cross-section contains gamma ray, resistivity, and porosity logs. The target interval for the proposed well is marked on the cross-section with a bracket. The cross-section demonstrates that the targeted interval is continuous across the proposed spacing unit.

8. On the right-hand side of COG Exhibit D-4 is a gunbarrel diagram showing the target for COG's initial well. COG Exhibit D-4 also shows the vertical interval to be pooled, between 9,925 feet and 10,551 feet total vertical depth, in relation to the proposed well.

9. In my opinion, standup orientation of the proposed well is the appropriate orientation for horizontal well development in this area because it is more near perpendicular to the maximum horizontal stress of the area.

10. Based on my geologic study, the Bone Spring formation underlying the subject area is suitable for development by horizontal wells and the acreage comprising the proposed spacing unit will contribute more-or-less equally to the production from the wellbore. I have not identified any geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells in the area of the spacing unit proposed.

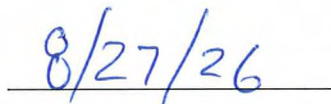
11. In my opinion, horizontal drilling will be the most efficient method to develop this acreage, to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and to result in the greatest ultimate recovery, and that approving COG's application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.

12. **COG Exhibits D-1 through D-4** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

Bonespring Base Subsea Structure Map

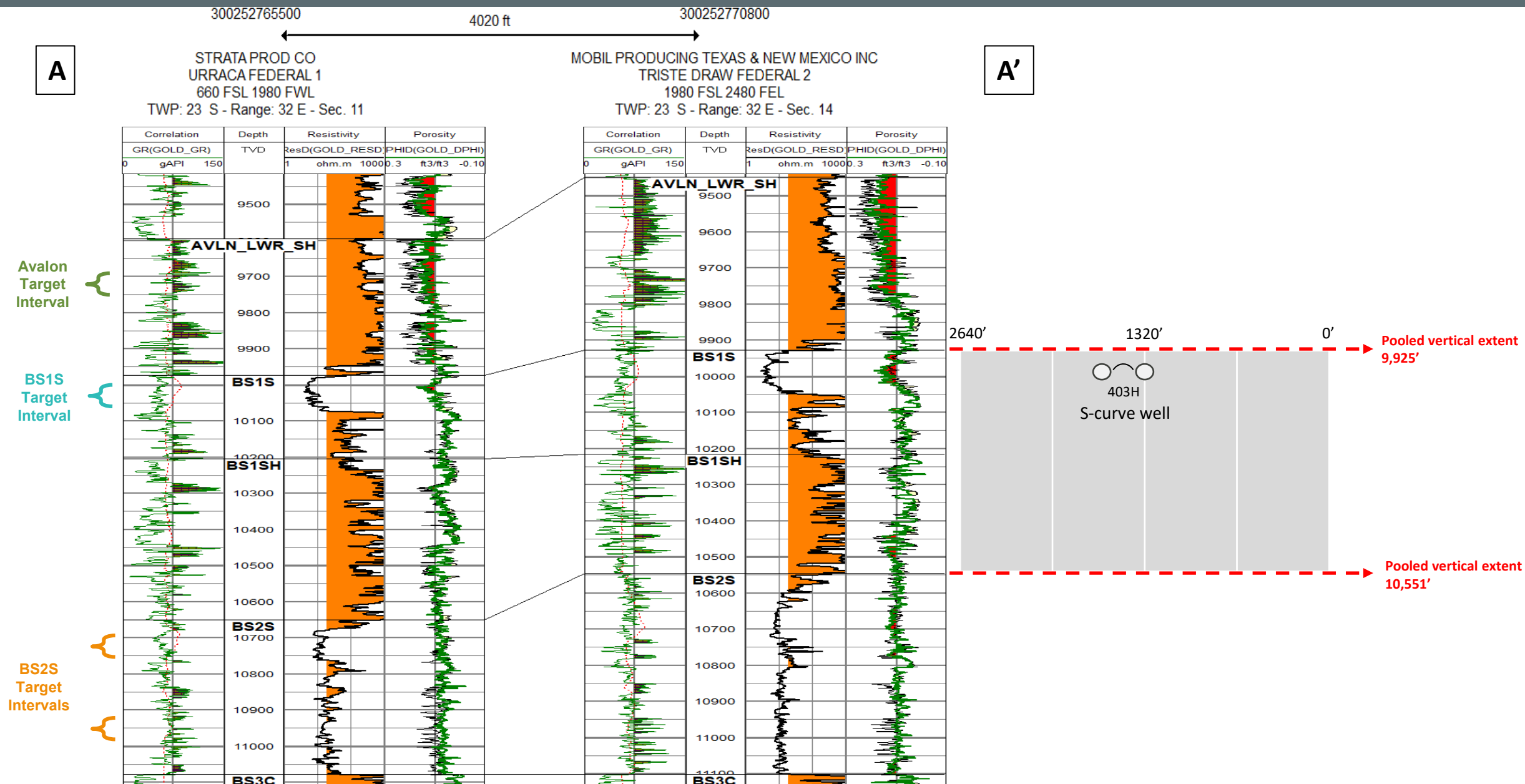

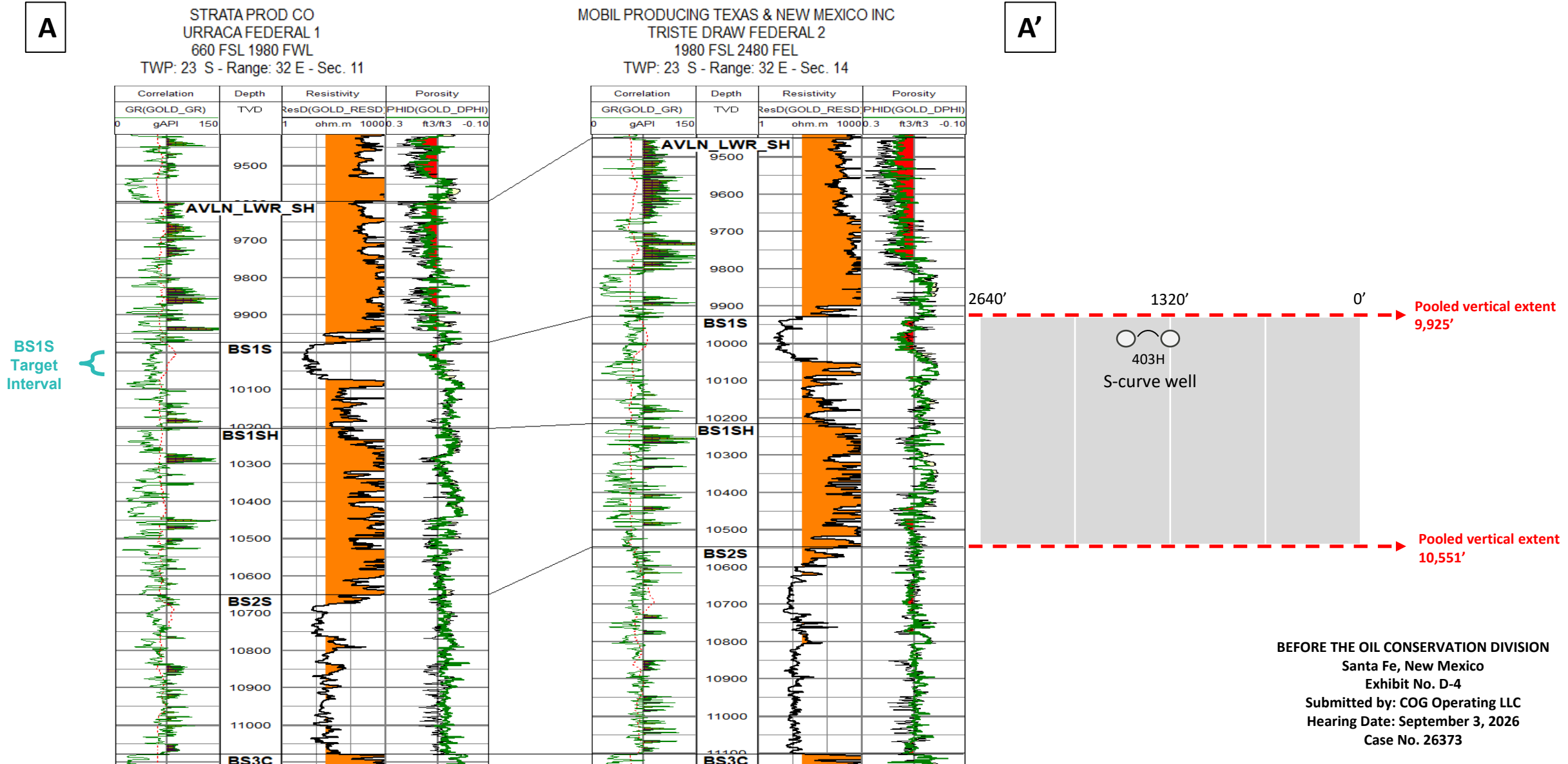
X-section location map
