APPLICATION OF XTO ENERGY INC. TO POOL ADDITIONAL INTEREST OWNERS UNDER THE TERMS OF ORDER NO. R-13903,

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on April 7, 2022, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On October 10, 2014, OCD issued Order R-13903 to XTO Energy Inc. ("Operator") to pool the uncommitted oil and gas interests within the specified spacing unit ("Unit").
- 2. Subsequent to the issuance of Order R-13903, Operator discovered previously unidentified interest owner(s) in the Unit.
- 3. Operator provided evidence that it gave notice of the Application and the hearing to the previously unidentified interest owner(s).
- 4. Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application.
- 5. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
- 7. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.
- 8. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
- 9. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
- 10. The previously unidentified interest owner has not agreed to commit its interest to the Unit.
- 11. The pooling of the previously unidentified uncommitted interest in the Unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
- 12. This Order affords to the previously unidentified interest owner the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

ORDER

- 13. The previously unidentified uncommitted interest in the Unit is hereby pooled in the Unit.
- 14. Order R-13903 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 15. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.
