ORDER GRANTING GRIFFIN'S MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

This matter comes before the Division on Griffin Energy Law, PLCC's (Griffin) *Unopposed Motion to Dismiss [Case No. 23779] with Prejudice* filed on October 6, 2023. Having considered the pleading and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, I FIND:

- Mewbourne Oil Company (Mewbourne) filed Case No. 21496 on October 5, 2020, a hearing was conducted on November 5, 2020, and Order No. R-21537 was issued on November 13, 2020.
- 2. Subsequently, Mewbourne discovered a previously unidentified interest owner in the unit and filed Case No. 21960, which was heard on June 17, 2021, and Order No. R-21537-A was issued on June 25, 2021.
- 3. On September 1, 2023, Griffin filed Applications to rescind Case Nos. 21496 and 21960.
- 4. Griffin and Mewbourne have since resolved their differences, and Griffin respectfully requests that Case No. 23779 be dismissed accordingly.
- 5. Mewbourne concurs with this request.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Case No 23779 is dismissed with prejudice.
