ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on June 27, 2024, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. BTA Oil Producers, LLC ("Operator") submitted an application ("Application") requesting an extension to drill the well(s) as required by Order R-22736.
- 2. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice of the Application was given.
- 3. Operator has demonstrated good cause to extend the deadlines required by Order R-22736.
- 4. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.
- 5. OCD issued Order R-22726-A on September 20, 2024. Order R-22726-A granted an extension to drill the well(s) as required by Order R-22724. The extension was granted in error.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
- 7. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
- 8. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.

ORDER

9. The period to drill the well(s) as required by Order R-22736 is extended until June 7, 2025.

- 10. Order R-22736 shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to drill and complete the well(s) as stipulated herein unless prior to termination Operator applies, and OCD grants, to amend Order R-22736 for good cause shown.
- 11. Order R-22726-A is terminated. The extension granted and requirements stipulated therein are revoked.
- 12. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.
