Description of Original Incident:

On May 1st of 1993, there was a release of fluids into secondary containment that originated from a valve. The release was all produced water and was approximately 160 bbls in volume. All fluid was recovered from containment. The location of this site is, O-13-12S-37E; <u>32.7126541</u>, -103.5503769.

Immediate Actions Taken:

A vacuum truck was called out to recover the fluid inside containment and the Victaulic clamp was replaced. As you can see in the following photos, the liner integrity remains intact.

Our current assessment of this incident was performed on June 3rd, 2020. With the information and pictures provided, we would like to respectfully request that the incident be closed out.
