During an elective flyover on August 18, 2025, a plume was identified at Rosa Unit 234A. Operations confirmed a malfunctioned PRV the same day, and the issue was repaired immediately upon

discovery. Follow-up OGI performed on August 20, 2025, confirmed all leaks were repaired.
