Gentlemen,

Reference is made to the herein enclosed NMOCD Order No. R-6259, dated February 7, 1980. The aforementioned Division Order established the 160-acre non-standard J.W. Sherrell Jalmat proration unit consisting of the E/2 SW/4 Section 31, T-24-S, R-37-E, and the NE/4 NW/4 and NW/4 NE/4 Section 6, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Division Order also approved for the production from the J.W. Sherrell No. 10 Jalmat Gas well to be dedicated to the 160-acre non-standard J.W. Sherrell Jalmat proration unit.

Recently, Doyle Hartman re-entered the previously plugged and abandoned J.W. Sherrell No. 5 Jalmat Gas well (location referenced above). We drilled out the cement plugs and cleaned out the wellbore and open-hole section of the subject well. After cleaning the open-hole section, we installed a 5-inch O.D. production liner, perforated, acidized, and fraced the Jalmat Gas interval. We returned the, previously plugged and abanodoned, J.W. Sherrell No. 5 well to active producing status as a Jalmat producer.

Returning the J.W. Sherrell No. 5 well to active producing status will facilitate the recovery of otherwise unrecoverable Jalmat gas reserves, thus preventing the waste of a valuable, clean burning energy source. By copy of this letter, Doyle Hartman hereby makes application for the simultaneous dedication of the J.W. Sherrell No. 5 Jalmat Gas well to the 160-acre non-standard J.W. Sherrell Jalmat proration unit.

Notice of this administrative application, and our request for written waiver (as enclosed herewith), has been sent by certified mail to the adjacent and diagonal Eumont operators, which operators are listed below.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 16, 1980, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 7th day of February, 1980, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Getty Oil Company, seeks approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, and the NW/4 NE/4 and NE/4. NW/4 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon at a point 660 feet from the North line and 2000 feet from the West line of said Section 6.
- (3) That the entire non-standard proration unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas from the Jalmat Gas Pool and that the entire non-standard gas proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the aforesaid well.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool, will prevent the

economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the E/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, and the NW/4 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon at a point 660 feet from the North line and 2000 feet from the West line of said Section 6.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.



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
