Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the NMOCD's herein-enclosed simultaneous dedication approval, of November 2, 1978, granting the right to simultaneously dedicate the Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" Nos. 1, 10, and 33 wells, to our 320-acre Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of the N/2 Section 7, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The 320-acre Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" proration unit was previously approved, effective April 1, 1970, under NMOCD Order No. R-3930.

As to the subject 320-acre Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" Jalmat (Gas) proration unit, we hereby **propose** the drilling of our Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" No. 34 well, as a *fourth active* Jalmat well, on the subject 320-acre proration unit, with the Myers "B" Federal R/A "A" No. 34 to be drilled in F-7-24S-37E, at a location no closer than 660' from the lease line.

Approval of this simultaneous dedication application will prevent waste, by allowing for the optimal recovery of remaining gas reserves (including gas reserves from tighter Jalmat strata, within the Jalmat interval). The subject application will also allow a material portion of the remaining reserves to be recovered during the current period of reduced North American gas deliverability and tighter gas supplies.

Notice of this administrative application, and our request for written waiver (as enclosed herewith), has been sent by certified mail to the applicable diagonal and adjacent offset Jalmat operators, which operators are as follows:





BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 4, 1970, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 11th day of March, 1970, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, is the owner and operator of two 160-acre non-standard gas proration units comprising the NW/4 and the NE/4 of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the NW/4 of said Section 7 is presently dedicated to applicant's Myers "B" Federal R/A A Well No. 1, located in Unit D of said Section 7, and that the NE/4 of said Section 7 is presently dedicated to applicant's Myers "B" Federal R/A A Well No. 10, located in Unit G of said Section 7.

(4) That the applicant now seeks the consolidation of the two existing non-standard gas proration units to form one 320-acre

non-standard gas proration unit comprising the N/2 of said Section 7, said unit to be simultaneously dedicated to its aforesaid Myers "B" Federal R/A A Wells Nos. 1 and 10.

(5) That the applicant further seeks authority to produce the allowable assigned to the unit from either of the aforesaid wells in any proportion.

(6) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the Myers "B" Federal R/A A Wells Nos. 1 and 10.

(7) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That, effective April 1, 1970, a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the N/2 of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and simultaneously dedicated to the Pan American Petroleum Corporation Myers "B" Federal R/A A Well No. 1, located in Unit D of said Section 7, and to the Pan American Petroleum Corporation Myers "B" Federal R/A A Well No. 10, located in Unit G of said Section 7.

(2) That the allowable assigned to the above-described non-standard gas proration unit shall be based upon the unit size of 320 acres; that the operator may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the subject wells in any proportion; and that the status of the consolidated unit shall be the combined status, as of April 1, 1970, of the two units being consolidated.
