NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR FLUID INJECTION WELL PERMIT

Stephens & Johnson Operating Co., P.O. Box 2249, Wichita Falls, TX 76307 is applying to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a permit to inject fluid into a formation which is productive of oil or gas. The applicant proposes to inject fluid into the Delaware Zone, Brushy Draw-Delaware Pool, Mobil 22 Federal Lease, Well Number 2. The proposed injection well is located in Sec. 22, T-26-S, R-29-E, 2310' FSL & 330' FEL, in Eddy County, New Mexico. Fluid will be injected into strata in the average subsurface depth interval from 5004 feet to 5068 feet. Expected maximum injection rate will be 1200 BWPD and the maximum injection pressure will be 1013 psig.

Interested parties must file objections or requests for hearings with the Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505.
