Reference is made to the following: (i) your application submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on July __, 2004 (*administrative application reference No. _____*); and (ii) the records of the Division in Santa Fe, including the files in Division Cases No. 8190 and 11497 and Division Administrative Orders NSL-3966(SD), as amended, NSL-3688(SD), NSL-4762(SD), and NSL-4873(SD): all concerning OXY USA, Inc.'s ("OXY") request for eleven (11) unorthodox Bravo Dome carbon dioxide gas (CO₂) well locations all within existing standard 640-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration units for the Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide (640-acre) Gas Pool (96010) within its Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit (BDCDGU), Union and Harding Counties, New Mexico:

(a) all of Section 18, Township 22 North, Range 34 East, NMPM, comprising 640 acres, which is currently dedicated to the BDCDGU "2234" Well No. 181 (**API No. 30-059-20338**), located at a standard CO₂ gas well location 1961 feet from the North line and 1979 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 18, is to be simultaneously dedicated to said Well No. 181 and to the proposed BDCDGU "2234" **Well No. 182 (API No. 30-059-20454)** to be drilled at an unorthodox CO₂ gas well location 330 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit D) of said Section 18;

(b) all of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 32 East, NMPM, comprising 640 acres, which is currently dedicated to the BDCDGU "2232" Well No. 351 (**API No. 30-059-20311**), located at a standard CO₂ gas well location 2000 feet from the North line and 2152 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 35, is to be simultaneously

Well No. 352 (API No. 30-059-20460) to be drilled at an unorthodox
CO₂ gas well location 1664 feet from the South line and 2578 feet from

From the information provided by the applicant, the royalty interests in all of the affected off-setting acreage to the proposed unorthodox locations have either been notified by certified mail or have ratified the Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit (BDCDGU) Agreement.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Bravo Dome 640-Acre Area*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-7556, dated June 19, 1984, as amended by Division Order No. R-7556-A, dated June 10, 1987, Secretary Paragraph No. (4) of Division Order No. R-10576, and Division Rule 104.F(2) the above-described BDCDGU "2234" Well No. 182 and BDCDGU "2232" Well No. 352, both to be drilled at unorthodox CO₂ gas well locations are hereby approved.

Jurisdiction of this matter shall be further retained for the entry of any such subsequent orders, as the Division may deem necessary.
