ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 10, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 3rd day of May, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., seeks approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 SW/4, S/2 SE/4, NE/4 SE/4, E/2 NE/4, and NW/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to its Roy Riddel Well No. 1, located in Unit N of said Section 12.

(3) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental section.

(4) That the entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Eumont Gas Pool.

(5) That the length or width of the proposed non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.

(6) That approval of the subject application will not cause waste or impair correlative rights if the Roy Riddel Well No. 2,

located 660 feet from the North line and 657 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is abandoned in the Eumont Gas Pool.

(7) That the proposed non-standard proration unit should be approved effective May 1, 1963, and that the production status of the non-standard proration unit should be the combined production status of the two wells formerly dedicated to this acreage as of April 30, 1963.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, W/2 SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and E/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to the Texaco Inc. Roy Riddel Well No. 1, located 661 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 12.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the Roy Riddel Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the North line and 657 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, shall be abandoned in the Eumont Gas Pool and a Notice of Disconnection filed with the Commission's Hobbs District Office.

(2) That this order shall be effective May 1, 1963, and that the production status of the non-standard proration unit created by this order shall be the combined production status of the two wells formerly dedicated to this acreage as of April 30, 1963.

(3) That Orders Nos. R-621 and R-622 are hereby superseded.

(4) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

It appearing to the Commission that due to clerical error, Order No. R-2477, dated May 3, 1963, does not correctly state the intended order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That Paragraph (1) on Page 2 of Order No. R-2477, dated May 3, 1963, is hereby corrected to read as follows:

"(1) That a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, E/2 SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and E/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to the Texaco Inc. Roy Riddel Well No. 1, located 661 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 12."

(2) That the correction set out hereinabove shall be effective nunc pro tunc as of May 1, 1963, the effective date of Order No. R-2477.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. on June 13, 1955 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 17th day of August, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and testimony adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That pursuant to provisions of Rule 5 (a) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520, the Commission has power and authority to permit the formation of a gas proration unit consisting of other than a legal section after notice and hearing by the Commission.

(3) That applicant, Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company is the owner of an oil and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico the land consisting of other than a legal section, and described as follows, to-wit:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
E/2 SE/4 of Section 11
and W/2 SW/4 of Section 12

containing 160 acres, more or less.

(4) That applicant, Sunray Mid-Continent Company has a producing well on the aforesaid lease known as the C. W. Marshall Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

(5) That the aforesaid well will be recompleted within the vertical and horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool, as said pool is delineated and designated in Order No. R-520.

(6) That it is impractical to pool applicant's said lease with adjoining acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool, and that the owners of adjoining acreage in said area have not objected to the formation of the proposed proration unit of 160 acres.

(7) That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aforesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas in the Eumont Gas Pool.

(8) That creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage will not cause but will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the application of Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company for approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
E/2 SE/4 of Section 11
and W/2 SW/4 of Section 12

be and the same is hereby approved, and a proration unit consisting of aforesaid acreage is hereby created.

(2) That applicant's well, C. W. Marshall Well No. 2, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, shall be granted an allowable in the proportion that the above described 160 acre unit bears to the standard or orthodox proration unit for said pool, all until further order of the Commission.
