Dear Ms. Cole:

Reference is the following: (i) your application dated May 16, 2000; and (ii) the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") records in Santa Fe: all concerning Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company's ("Burlington") request for an off-pattern non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for the proposed Allison Unit Com. Well No. 150 (API No. 30-045-30154) to be drilled 1150 feet from the South line and 1605 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 8, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 1 and 2, the S/2 NE/4, and the SE/4 (E/2 equivalent) of Section 8 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 277.51-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
