
Dear Sir:

Your administrative approval is requested to down hole commingle marginal production in the subject well which is dually completed in the South Brunson Ellenburger and Blinbery Oil Pools. Recent approval was granted and work completed to down hole commingle these pools in our Scarborough Estate No. 7 well. The subject well is a direct offset with similar production history and producing characteristics.

Down hole commingling of the two pools will increase pumping efficiency and productive life of this well. Waste will not occur and correlative rights will not be violated. Ownership in the two pools is common. If secondary operations become practical in the future for this well, the pools could be dually completed.

Pertinent details outlined in Order R-3845 are attached for your consideration.





ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 21, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 27th day of February, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks authority to complete its Scarborough Estate Well No. 7, located in Unit K of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Blinbry Oil Pool and an undesignated Ellenburger oil pool through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, with separation of zones by a packer set at approximately 7775 feet.

(3) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to complete its Scarborough Estate Well No. 7, located

in Unit K of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a dual completion (conventional) to produce oil from the Blinebry Oil Pool and an undesignated Ellenburger oil pool through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, with separation of zones by a packer set at approximately 7775 feet.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations insofar as said rule is not inconsistent with this order.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Ellenburger formation.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.


