This is a request for administrative approval for a non-standard gas well located in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs pool.

Burlington Resources plans to re-complete this well in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs formation and commingle with the existing Basin Fruitland Coal formation. Order DHC 11363 is the order that we will be referencing to apply for the DHC for this well (see attached application).

Production from the Pictured Cliffs is included in a 160-acre gas spacing unit comprising of the southeast quarter of Section #12. The well is standard for the Fruitland Coal interval, but non-standard for the Pictured Cliffs interval. The interest is common between the FTC and PC interval in this section. Also Burlington is the offset operator and 100% WI Owner for both the NE/4 of Section 12 and the NW/4 of Section 7, therefore no notification is required. Currently economics dictate only adding the Pictured Cliffs interval to this well if the NSL approval is granted.

It is intended to drill and complete the subject well in the Basin Fruitland Coal (Pool Code 721629) and the Aztec Pictured Cliffs (Pool code 71280). The production will be commingled according to Oil Conservation Division Order Number 11363. Allocation and methodology will be provided after the well is completed. Commingling will not reduce the value of production. The Bureau of Land Management has been notified in writing of this application.

The interest is common between the FTC & PC intervals on the subject well therefore no notice is being sent to the interest owners. The BLM will receive this notice.
