Reference is made to your request of July 14, 1986 for the cancellation of Division Orders Nos. DHC-111 and DHC-179. These permits authorized the downhole commingling of the Skaggs Glorieta and Drinkard Pools within the wellbores of the C. H. Weir "A" Nos. 4 and 7 Wells, respectively. It is our understanding that the Glorieta formation has been cement squeezed in both wells and is no longer producing, thereby eliminating the need for downhole commingling authority.

As per your request, Division Orders Nos. DHC-111 and DHC-179 are hereby cancelled.

Gentlemen:

It is requested that the subject DHC Order be cancelled due to the abandonment of Skaggs Glorieta zone and subsequent single completion of the Skaggs Drinkard zone.

The Glorieta and Drinkard zones were completed in one string of 5-1/2" casing. Glorieta perms at 5300' - 5320' have been squeezed with 100 sacks of cement and abandoned. The Drinkard zone is the remaining single completion in this wellbore.

Your consideration for this permit cancellation will be appreciated.
