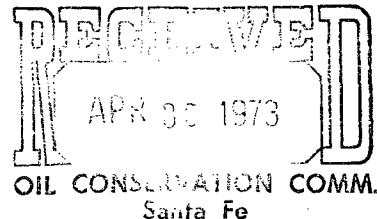

A. H. Blinebry Federal (NCT-1) Well No. 26  
Blinebry (Oil) and Drinkard (Oil) Pools

Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Order No. R-3845 to commingle in the wellbore production from the Blinebry and Drinkard Pools which are dually completed as permitted by Administrative Order No. MC-1643 dated July 6, 1965, in Well No. 26 on the A. H. Blinebry Federal (NCT-1) Lease, Battery 2, located in Unit B of Section 29, Township 22-South, Range 38-East, Lea County, New Mexico.

The subject well, for which wellbore commingling approval is requested, qualifies under the provisions of Statewide Rule 303C, which provides for administrative application and approval of wellbore commingling. Both zones are classified as oil zones and produce oil and gas at rates below the limits specified in the subject order. Both the Blinebry and Drinkard zones are produced by artificial lift; therefore, the commingled production will be produced in the same manner. Neither the Blinebry nor the Drinkard zone produce water in the subject well. The fluids from these reservoirs have been commingled in common storage on the surface for several years and are known to be compatible. There is no evidence of scale or precipitates forming due to commingling these zones. The total value of the crudes will not be reduced as both pools are currently produced into common lease storage and sold commingled. The working interest, royalty and overriding royalty interest on both zones are common. Future secondary recovery operations will not be jeopardized in either zone by commingling.

To comply with the above mentioned order, a data sheet is attached with all the required data pertaining to the two reservoirs currently being produced in the subject well. Also attached is a production curve which may be used to allocate production. Well tests are included as submitted on Form C-116.

As the lease on which the subject well is located is a Federal Lease, a copy of this application is being submitted to the U.S. Geological Survey. Copies are also being mailed to each of the offset operators shown on the attached list.

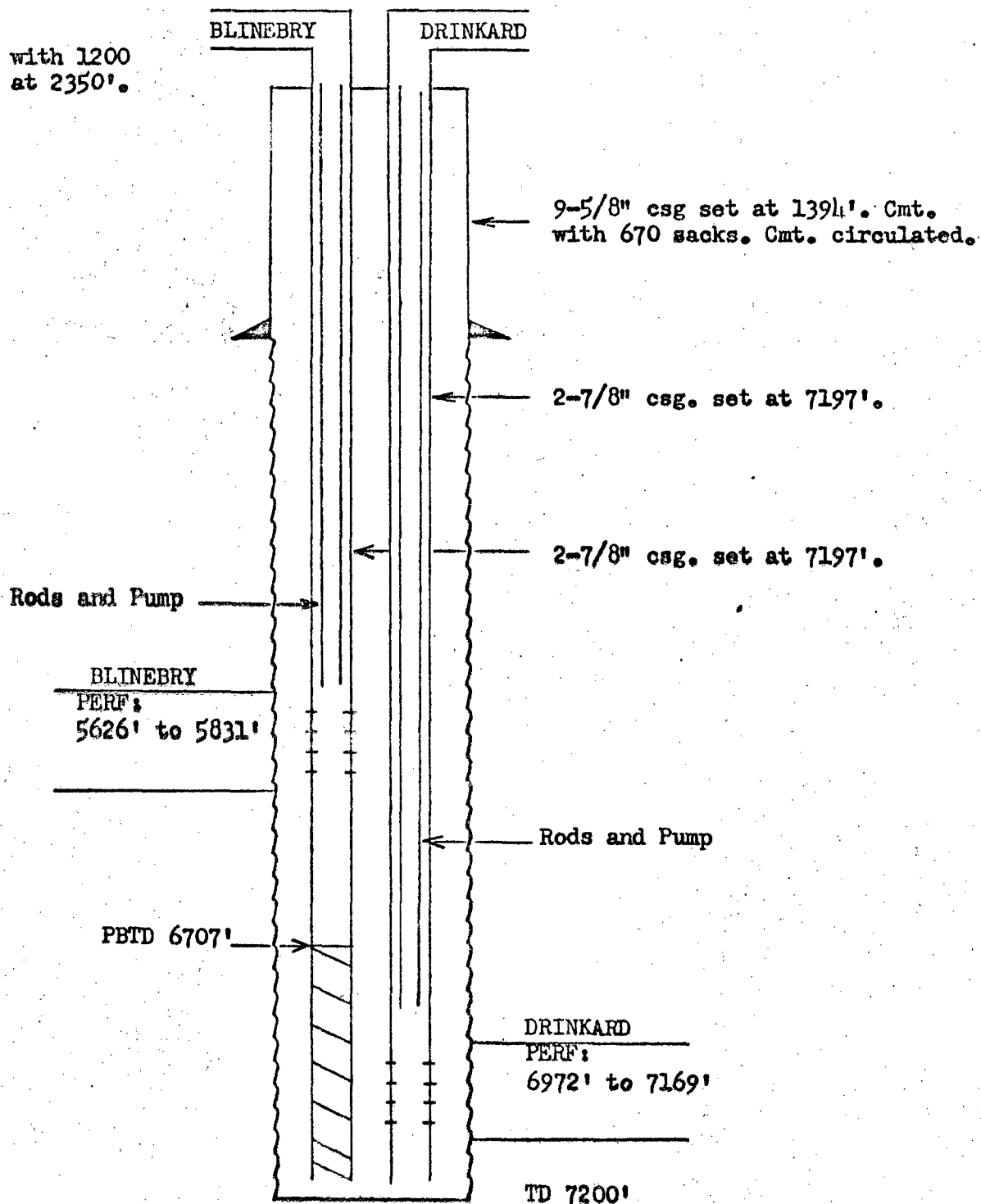

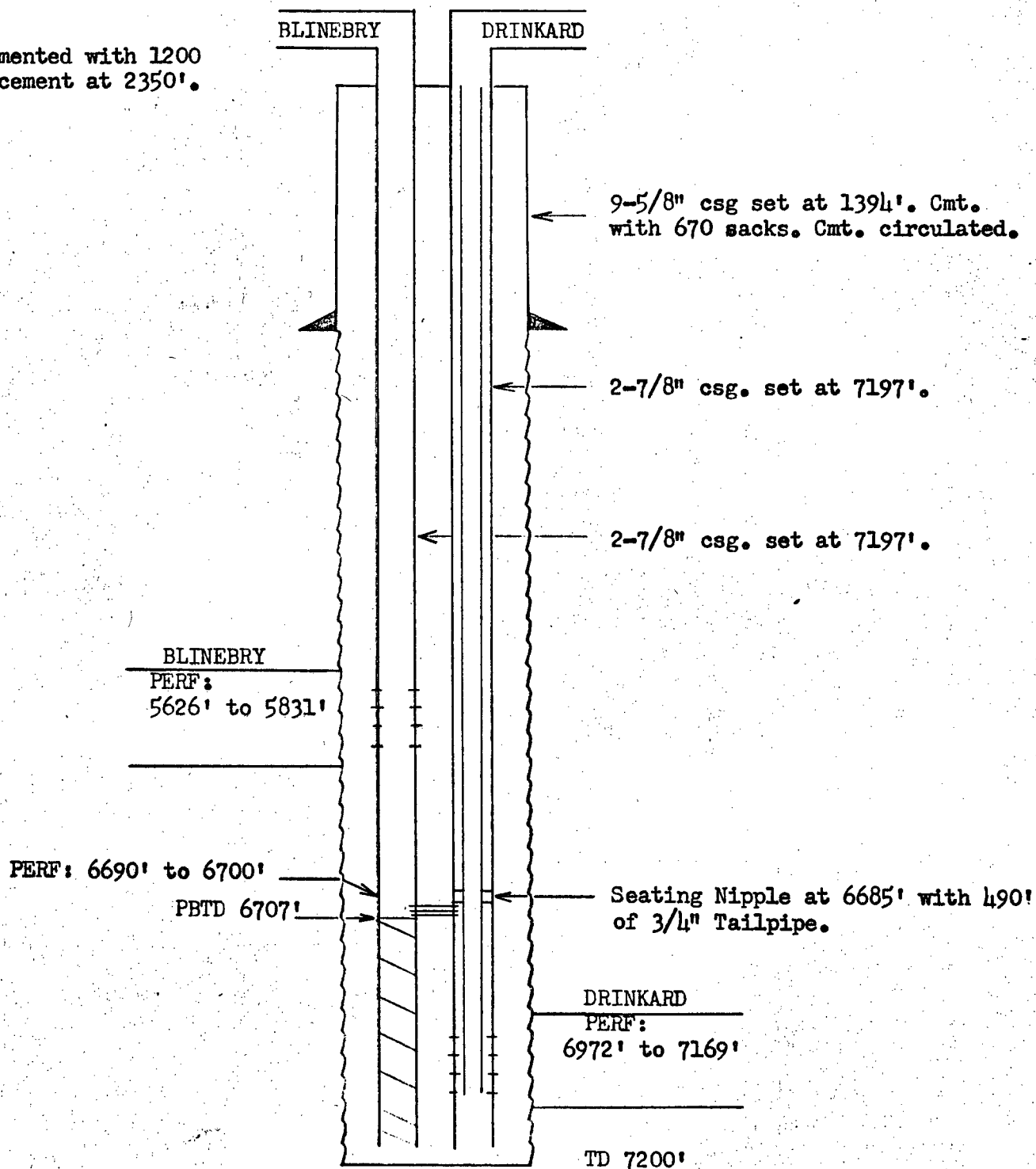

No well will be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on the official test.

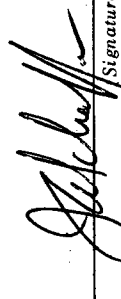
During gas-oil ratio test, each well shall be produced at a rate not exceeding the top unit allowable for the pool in which well is located by more than 25 percent. Operator is encouraged to take advantage of this 25 percent tolerance in order that well can be assigned increased allowables when authorized by the Commission.

Gas volumes must be reported in MCF measured at a pressure base of 15.025 psia and a temperature of 60° F. Specific gravity base will be 0.60.

Report casing pressure in lieu of tubing pressure for any well producing through casing.

Mail original and one copy of this report to the district office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in accordance with Rule 301 and appropriate pool rules.

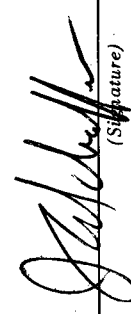

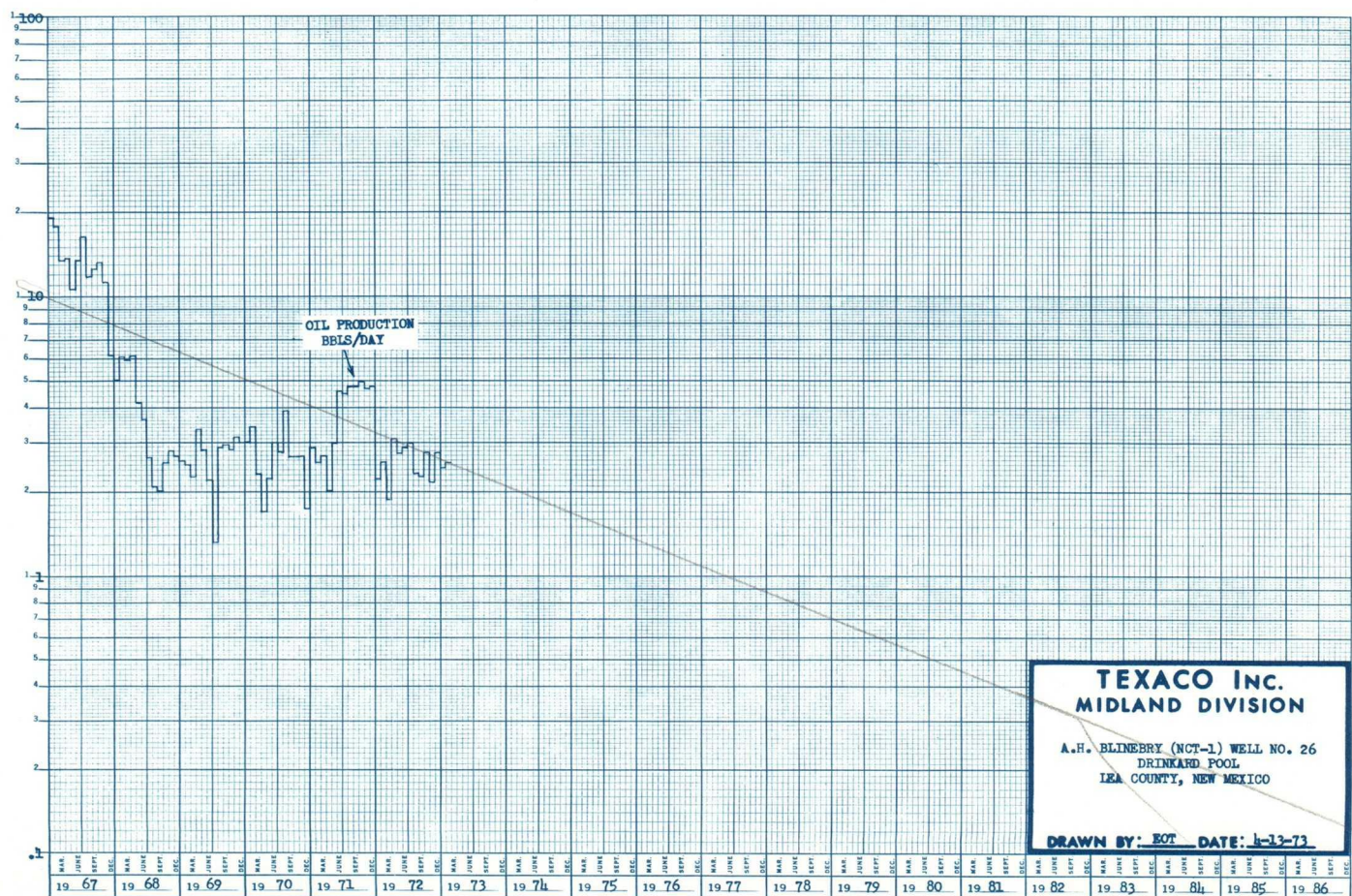
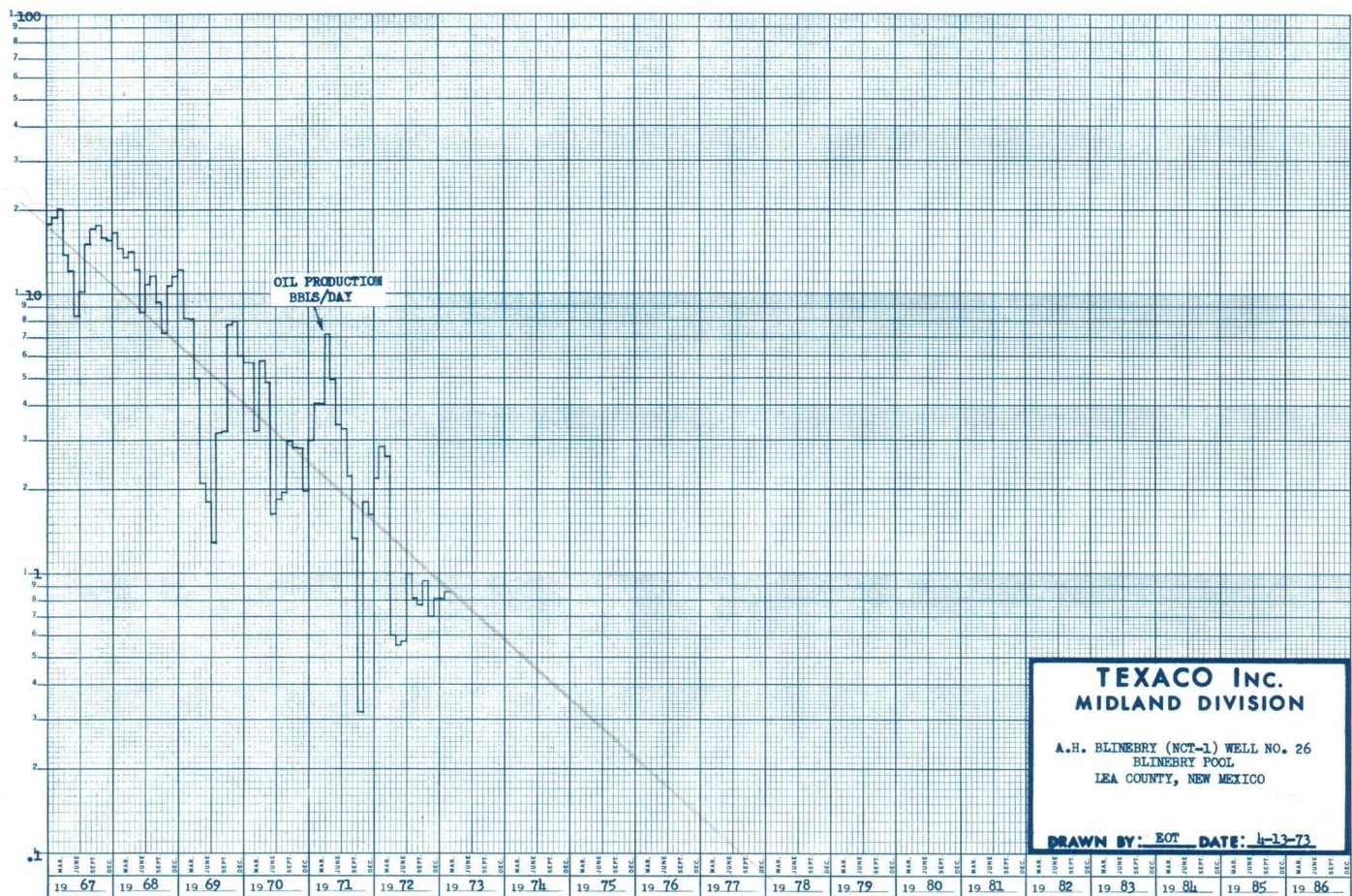
