A. B. Coates "C" Well No. 18 Unit I, Sec. 24, T-25S, R-37E, Re: NMPM, Justis Blinebry, Tubb-Drinkard and Elleburger Pools, Lea County, New Mexico

Reference is made to your recent application for an Gentlemen: exception to Rule 303-A of the Division Rules and Regulations to permit the subject well to commingle the production from said pools in the wellbore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303-C, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the said zones, is hereby placed in abeyance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303.C.4., total commingled oil production from the subject well shall not

exceed 50 barrels per day, and total water production from the exceed 50 barrels per day. The maximum amount well shall not exceed 100 barrels per day. The well shall be of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be of gas which may be produced daily from the allowable for the determined by multiplying 2,000 by top unit allowable for the Justis Ellenburger.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Justis Blinebry Pool: Oil 33 %, Gas 84 %
Tubb Drinkard Pool: Oil 14 %, Gas 11 %
Ellenburger Pool: Oil 53 % Gas 5%
