Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303-A of the Division Rules and Regulations the down-hole separation equipment and to commingle the production from both pools in the wellhore

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval and that reservoir damage or waste provisions of Rule 303-C, violated thereby, and correlative rights will not such production as described above and any administrative oil completion and required separation of the two zones, is hereby

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303.C.4., total exceed 40 barrels per day, and total water production from the of gas which may be produced by multiplying 2,000 by top unit allowable for the

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Blinebry Oil & Gas Pool: Oil 55 %, Gas 33 % Warren Tubb Pool: Oil 45 %, Gas 67 %
