Provided: The operator shall not begin injection into this well until all pre-conditions contained in the original order are complied with.

The injection authority for this well shall expire on December 17, 2005, if the operator has not commenced injection operations.

Devon Energy Production Company would like to request an extension of approval, to convert the H B 11 Federal #11 to water injection. Devon Energy's Form C-108, Application for Authorization to Inject was approved December 17, 2003 (Administrative Order SWD-910). Devon was not able to initiate work to convert the H B 11 Federal #11 to water injection within the allowed one year approval period, due to work scheduling conflicts. It is anticipated that the salt water disposal conversion will be completed by the second quarter 2005.

The well's area of review has been re-checked. Surface and leasehold positions remain the same as reported in the original Form C108 filing. In addition, there have been no wellbores added within the well's area of review.
