



WORKPLAN

General:

A C-141 was filed and BLM and OCD was notified of the water flow. Will repair well and remediate spill area.

Groundwater:

According to State Engineer and groundwater information, the depth of water occurs at approximately 300 feet below surface.

Remediation Proposal:

Our cleanup will be to excavate contaminated soil, haul to an OCD approved facility and replace with clean soil and seed. Before backfilling, the area will be tested for TPH, BTEX and Chloride to assure we meet OCD guidelines, and only after OCD and BLM approve, we will backfill and level.

The OCD and BLM will be notified of all activities and a report will be filed upon completion.

Ranking Criteria Score: 0

This site has a 5000 ppm TPH cleanup and will cleanup BTEX and Chloride per OCD.


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Hole in casing causing injection water to come to surface, and into pattern shot in injection, vacuum up water, build emergency pit to catch water, also put track tank to hold water. Waiting on pulling unit to repair well.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Ran into pattern south + west; water pooled up in low spot approx 125 ft south. area (110x80) water soaked. Ran west on small drain, 264 ft wide approx 150 ft. All available water vacuumed up. (will file Work Plan for remediation)
