Greetings,

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a document titled "Soil Assessment and Remediation Work Plan" (plan), dated June 28, 2011. The plan was formulated and presented to OCD by Quantum Resources Management's agent, Talon, LPE. The plan proposes procedures to be taken for remediation of a produced fluid release, referenced above.

The plan is approved with the following conditions and/or stipulations:

- Notify OCD 48 hours prior to commencement of remedial activities.
- Notify OCD 48 hours prior to obtaining samples where the analyses will be presented to OCD.
- The plan proposes to use a compacted clay barrier or a 20 mil liner. It is OCD's understanding that a 20 mil liner will be utilized and not a clay barrier.
- Notify OCD 48 hours prior to installation of liner.
- Liner is to be installed, at a minimum, 4 feet below natural surface grade.
- Confirmation sidewall samples may be required. Contact OCD prior to backfilling any excavation.
- Like approval by any other regulatory authority as may be applicable.
- Submit a Form C-141 Final Report and closure report upon satisfactory completion of project.
- Project is to be completed and closure documentation submitted to OCD not later than October 3, 2011.

Be advised, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
