EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Condor 32 State No. 701H Well** to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S253336D; Upper Wolf Camp (Pool Code 98094) underlying Section 32, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 160 feet from the North line and 937 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 32. The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from North line and 1356 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 32 and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the South line and 1356 feet from the East line of Section 32 (Unit O). Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the northeastern, eastern, and southeastern boundaries of the project area. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow for efficient spacing of horizontal wells and thereby prevent waste.

Exhibit A is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Condor 32 State No. 701H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the Northeast, East, and Southeast.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Section 32 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Condor 32 State No. 701H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.



Exhibit C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the Southeast. Each of these parties have been provided notice of this application by certified mail. EOG is the sole operator and mineral lessee of the state lease covering Section 32. Accordingly, there are no affected parties by the encroachment to the East. EOG is also the sole operator of the federal lease in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 29. Accordingly, there are no affected parties by the encroachment to the Northeast. Nonetheless, a copy of this application has been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office and the Bureau of Land Management.




