EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Barlow 34 Fed Com No. 704Y Well** (API No. 30-025-44262) to be completed within the Sanders Tank; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (98097) underlying Sections 27 and 34, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 300 feet from the South line and 1629 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 34. The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from South line and 1382 feet from the West line (Unit B) of Section 34 and the lower most perforation will be 2309 feet from the South line and 1378 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 27. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the western, southwestern, and northwestern boundaries of the project area.

EOG will be the operator of three permitted wells in the W/2 SW/4 of Section 27 and the W/2 NW/4 (W/2 W/2): the Barlow 34 Fed Com No. 701H Well, and the Barlow 34 Fed Com No. 702H Well. Ownership in the Wolfcamp is identical between the proposed spacing unit and the spacing unit in the W/2 SW/4 of Section 27 and the W/2 NW/4 of Section 34. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.



Exhibit A is a draft Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Barlow 34 Fed Com No. 704Y Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the West, Northwest, and Southwest.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Sections 27 and 34 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Barlow 34 Fed Com No. 704Y Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.

Exhibit C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the Southwest. As described above, EOG is the operator in the spacing proration unit comprised of the W/2SW/4 of Section 27 and the W/2NW/4 of Section 34 and ownership is identical to the proposed spacing unit. Accordingly, there are no affected parties in the spacing units to the West of the proposed well. EOG is the operator and 100% working interest owner of the spacing unit to the Northwest. Accordingly, there are no affected parties in the spacing unit to the Northwest. Each of the parties listed on Exhibit C have been provided notice of this application by certified mail. A copy of this application has been provided to the State Land Office.

Exhibit D is an affidavit from the landman verifying that ownership in W/2SW/4 of Section 27 and the W/2NW/4 of Section 34 is identical to the proposed spacing unit.




