Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. (“Devon”) respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for the Fighting Okra 18-19 Fed 2H well to be completed in the WC-025 G-09 S253336D; UPPER WOLFCAMP Pool (98094), API Number 30-025-43991. As shown on the enclosed C-102, the permitted surface location is 330’ FNL and 1,665’ FWL of Section 18-T26S-R34E, with a permitted bottom hole location 330’ FSL and 960’ FWL of Section 19-T26S-R34E. The projected FTP (first take point) is expected to be approximately 660’ FNL and 1,260’ FWL of Section 18-T26S-R34E, and projected LTP (last take point) is expected to be approximately 330’ FSL and 960’ FWL of Section 19-T26S-R34E. The reason for permitting this well at an unorthodox location is to maximize recovery.

Please be advised that Devon and Chevron U.S.A. Inc., combined, own 100% of the Federal leasehold interest in all of Section 18-T26S-R34E, as well as all of Section 19-T26S-R34E; therefore, notice is not required. Chevron will be sent a courtesy copy of this application.

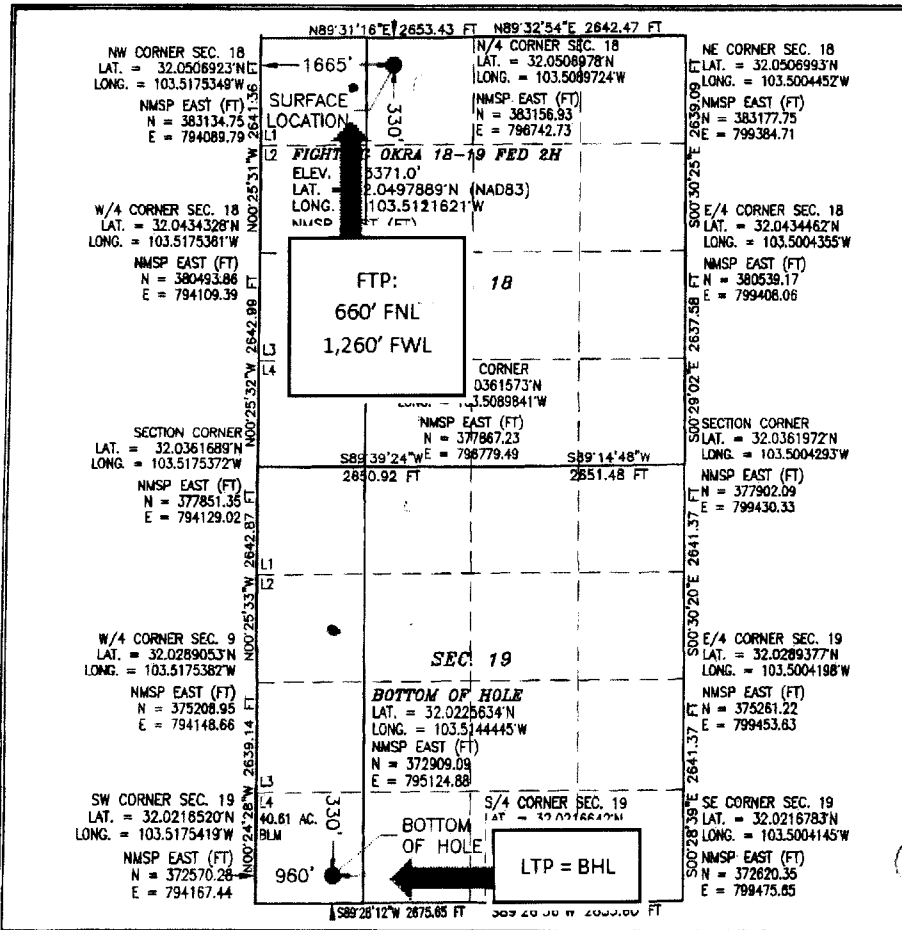

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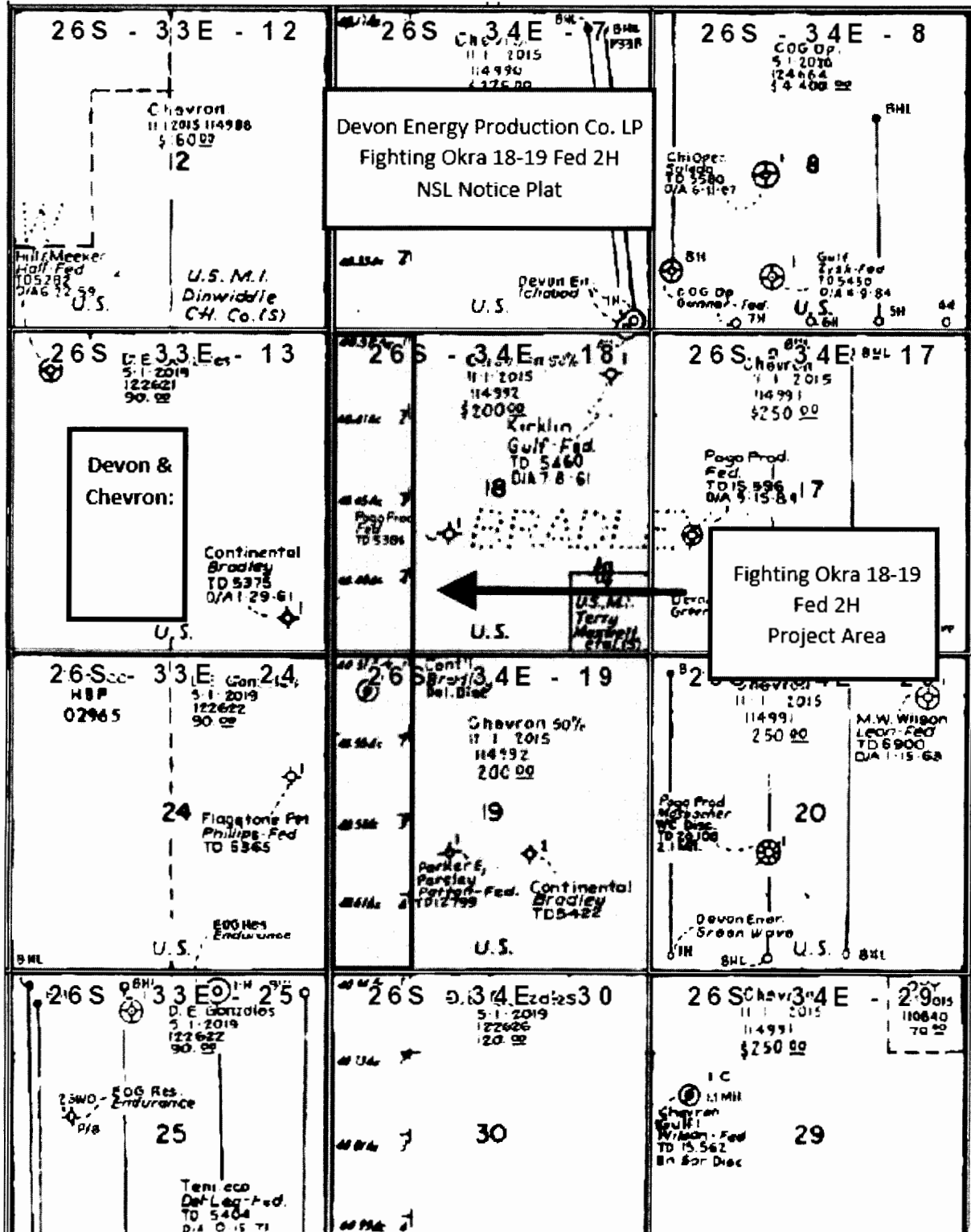
