You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Rule 19.15.15.9.A NMAC, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary.

This well's completed interval is as close as 100 feet from the western and eastern edge, and 345 feet on the diagonal of the penetration point and the final perforation location, of the project area and therefore will cause an encroachment toward the following tracts:

Section 5, encroachment to the SE/4 SE/4 Section 8, encroachment to the NE/4 NE/4 Section 3, encroachment to the SW/4 SE/4 Section 10, encroachment to the NW/4 NE/4

It is also understood that you have given due notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Rule 19.15.4.12 A (2) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

It is our understanding that the Applicant is seeking this location to reduce waste while protecting correlative rights, and improving well economics from the Yeso formation underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 4 and the S/2 SW/4 of Section 3.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A (2) NMAC.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
