Melanie:

I have reviewed your request to extend order SWD-1610 and the Division will honor the request. However, this may be the opportunity to resolve the conflict of the surface location between the approved APD (1659 FSL, 268 FWL) and the current SWD order ( 220 FNL, 305 FWL). If you would submit a second correspondence requesting an amended order for the new surface location with the following findings:

1. Are the same AOR wells for both the original application location and the new location? If so, state this. Or if the re-location includes a new AOR well, please provide this information.
2. Does the shift in surface location change the affect persons – those notified in the original application within the ½-mile radius? If there is a new operator, then they will have to be notified.
