Reference is made to your application received on March 28, 2018.

You have requested this unorthodox oil well location for the subject well described above in the referenced pool or formations. This location is governed by statewide Rule 19.15.15.9.A NMAC, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is unorthodox it is too close to the southern and western boundary of the unit.

This subject well's completed interval is as close as 120 feet from the southern edge, and 20 feet from the western boundary; therefore, will cause an encroachment toward the following tracts:

Section 7, encroachment to the S/2 NE/4 and NW/4 NE/4

It is also understood that you have given due notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Rule 19.15.4.12 A (2) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. However, the ownership is identical in the proposed spacing unit and the affected tracts. Therefore, no notification is required.

It is our understanding that the Applicant is seeking this location because this is the preferred geological location which allows the maximum recovery of hydrocarbons, and prevent waste.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A (2) NMAC.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
