Reference is made to your application received on March 12, 2018.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. Subsection B of 19.15.15.9 NMAC governs this pool and provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary.

This well's completed interval is as close as 100 feet to the eastern and western edge, and 442 feet to the northeastern and northwestern edges. Encroachments will impact the following tracts.

- Section 9, encroachment to the SE4/ SE4
- Section 11, encroachment to the SW4/ SW4
- Section 14, encroachment to the NW4/ NW4
- Section 16, encroachment to the NE4/ NE4

Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.


Division understands you seek this location to maximize the recovery of oil and gas reserves within the project area.
