OFF-LEASE MEASUREMENT

Devon Energy Production Company, LP (OGRID 6137) is hereby authorized to transport and measure oil and gas production off-lease, from the following wells which produce from the Bone Spring formation, the Los Medanos; Bone Spring Pool (pool code 40295) in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Ko Lanta 9 4 Federal Com Well No. 518H (API No. 30-015-44864), Unit P, Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 31 East.

Ko Lanta 9 4 Federal Com Well No. 528H (API No. 30-015-44865), Unit P, Section 9, Township 23 South, Range 31 East.

The oil and gas production from these wells shall be measured and sold at the Maldives 15 Central 1 Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit D of Section 15, Township 23 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

All meters for the above-referenced wells shall be physically separated from facilities for other wells, so that production from the above-referenced wells will not be commingled prior to measurement with production from any other well.

This permit does not authorize the surface commingling of this oil and gas production with production from other pools or leases.

It is also understood that you have given due notice of this application to all working interest owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Division Rule 19.15.23.9 (A) NMAC.

Applicant may add future wells in the lease and pool approved by this administrative order with a Sundry Notice C-103 to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division before commencement of Off-Lease Measurement.
