Laura,

After a review of the Rodman State SWD #1 well application (SWD-2227), it appears that there is sufficient information regarding notice to affected parties to unsuspend the application. However, the application is currently protested by Matador Resources and NGL Water Solutions. Therefore, the OCD is still unable to approve the application administratively. There are currently two options for proceeding with this application; the first is to go to hearing, the second is to negotiate a resolution with the protesting party. If the protest is withdrawn, then the application can be reviewed administratively. In the meantime, the application will be retained pending a hearing or other resolution.

Additionally, on initial review it appears that the application did not reference the name and manufacturer of the intended packer to be used in the well. This and potentially other information will be required for the application to proceed through the technical review process.
