Dear Mr. Holcomb:

Reference is made to your August 15, 2019 request on behalf of Judah Oil LLC (the "operator") to extend the deadline stipulated in the above titled order to commence injection for the above referenced well for reasons outlined in your correspondence. The current deadline date to commence injection under said order is two years after issuance of the order: November 20, 2019.

It is the Division's understanding from your correspondence that since the date of issuance of this permit, no additional wells that penetrate the approved injection interval drilled in the one half-mile Area of Review (AOR). However, one new affected party within the AOR, Marathon Oil Permian LLC, was noticed and filed a protest on August 23, 2019. Subsequently, Marathon Oil Permian LLC withdrew its protest on December 17, 2019, and the extension request could be reviewed administratively for approval.

The Division finds that for reasons you have stated, the granting of this request to extend this administrative order is in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste, and will protect the environment. Therefore, the deadline to commence injection for the existing order is hereby extended until November 20, 2020.

All requirements of the above referenced administrative order and agreements in the application remain in full force and effect. Any additional extension of the deadline to commence injection for this administrative order will not be considered unless the operator has already commenced drilling of the referenced well. Otherwise, the injection authority shall expire under the terms of the extended administrative order and the operator shall be required to submit a new application to obtain injection authority for the referenced well.

Dear Mr. McMillan,

Judah Oil, LLC respectfully requests an administrative extension for injection authority for the subject well. Injection authority is set to expire on November 20, 2019. Judah Oil, LLC requests an extension be granted for one year for good cause. Judah Oil, LLC is a small operator with only one field representative. Since the approval of this injection authority, Judah has initiated two SWD wells and facilities as noted below:

Well: Shinnery Oak Federal SWD #1 (30-015-20866)

Injection Authority: AO SWD-1704 approved 3/4/15 (10/25/17 authority extension to 3/4/18)

Re-entry commenced: 11/6/2017

Completion ready: 12/15/2017

First injection: March, 2018

Well: Mile Marker 5 State SWD #1 (30-015-44818)

Injection Authority: AO SWD-1756 approved 10/3/2018 (for 1 year period)

Spud date: 11/16/2018

Completion ready: 3/25/2019

First injection: June, 2019

Judah is now focused on drilling and constructing the Doodle Bug State SWD #1. However, as you can see from the Mile Marker 5 State SWD #1 timeline above, Judah cannot have the Doodle Bug well and facilities ready for first injection within 3-1/2 months. The time required to drill, complete and test a 17,000 foot well, then obtain NMSLO rights-of-way and leases for the surface facilities and then build those facilities requires more time. Therefore, Judah Oil, LLC respectfully requests a one year extension on the injection authority in order to implement the Doodle Bug State SWD #1.

Since the application for injection authority was approved on November 20, 2017, four additional wells have been permitted/drilled, but no completions reported within the 0.5 mile radius area of review. No wells within the 0.5 mile AOR penetrate the proposed injection interval. The operator of the four new wells was notified during the original injection application and did not protest. Attached is a copy of the updated 0.5 mile radius AOR map for offset wells and a list of the new offset wells titled "Exhibit C".

Since original application submission, there has been one change in the affected parties within the 0.5 mile radius AOR. Attached is a copy of the updated 0.5 mile AOR map for affected parties titled "Exhibit F". Marathon now operates acreage in Section 15, T22S, R33E. In 2017, we notified the lessees of those two leases since no operator was identified. Attached is a copy of the Marathon notice signature receipt.

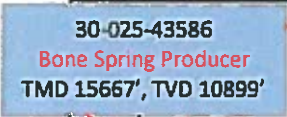

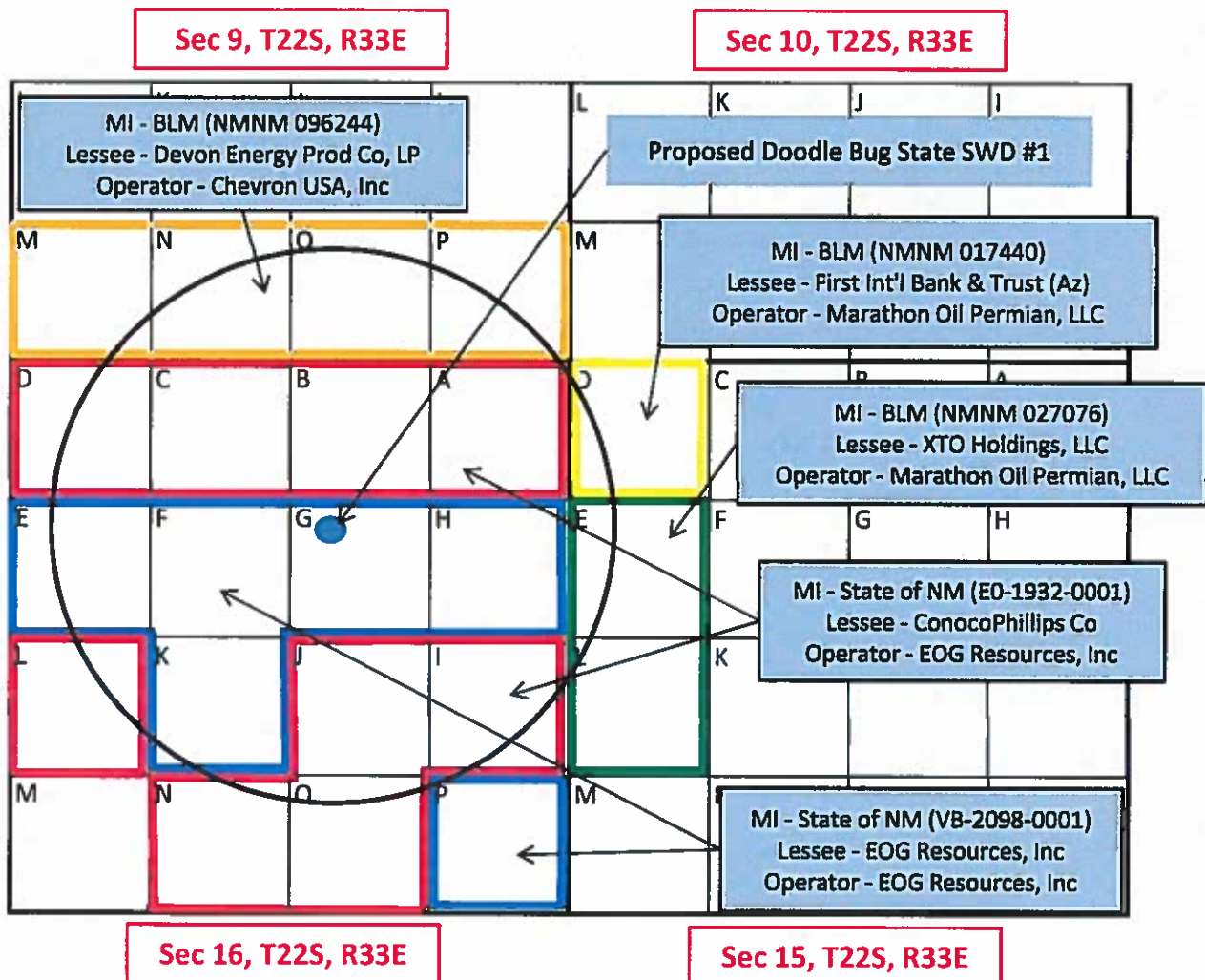

Judah Oil, LLC applied for and received an approved Administrative Order SWD-1704 dated November 20, 2017 from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to drill and complete the Doodle Bug State SWD #1 (30-025-44144) as a Devonian/Silurian SWD well in Unit Letter G, Section 16, T22S, R33E, Lea County, New Mexico. Judah is now applying to the NMOCD for a one year extension to this injection authority.

The proposed disposal interval would be the Devonian-Silurian formations through open-hole completion between 16420' – 17200'. Disposal fluid would be produced water from producing oil and gas wells in the area. Anticipated average disposal volume is 14,000 BWPD with a maximum anticipated volume of 18,000 BWPD. Anticipated average disposal pressure is 2200 psi with a maximum disposal pressure of 3284 psi. The well would be located approximately 19.8 miles southwest of Oil Center, New Mexico.

You are receiving this letter notice because you have been identified as an operator of non-producing acreage (see attachment) within 0.5 miles of the subject well. BLM records indicate you became the operator of this acreage in 2017.

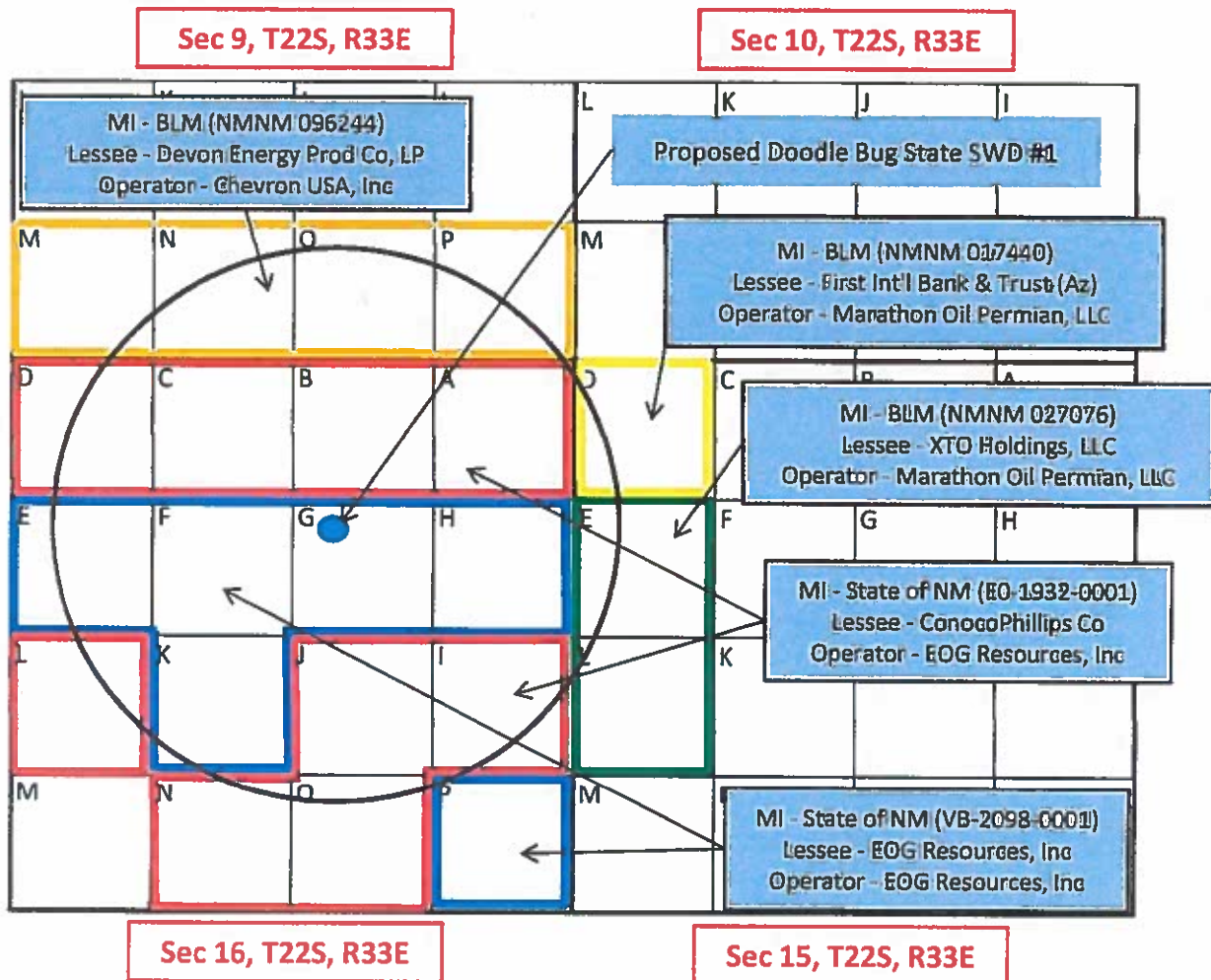

I have worked out an agreement with 3 Bears Energy on the Doodle Bug State #1 SWD. I will be transferring operations over as soon as the extension for 1 year has been granted by the NMOCD. They are ready to move forward with drilling the SWD and putting it into service as soon as possible.

As you are aware, Marathon has protested the extension due to their concerns of an area fault. 3 Bears has spoken with Marathon and have ran a fall slip analysis. What the findings show is no signs of fault slippage with rates up to at least 25,000 bwpd. Marathon has agreed to withdraw their protest and should be notifying the NMOCD in the next couple of weeks.

On August 23, 2019, Marathon Oil Permian submitted a protest following notice of the requested extension since Marathon was a new affected party not in the original notice effort.

With this protest, the SWD order could not be extended administratively but the authority to inject for the order was maintained as valid pending outcome of the protest. On December 17, 2019, Marathon, through its legal counsel, withdrew its protest making possible the extension of the order by administrative approval of the Director. OCD should have an extension letter formalizing this outcome sometime this week. The new date to commence will be November 20, 2020.
