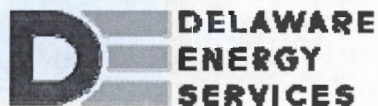

The well name is the Super Siphon State SWD #2, and is located 1316' FSL & 250' FWL, Unit Letter M, Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. The well will dispose of water produced from nearby oil and gas wells into the Devonian formation from a depth of 17,292 feet to 19,026 feet. The maximum expected injection rate is 50,000 BWPD at a maximum surface injection pressure of 3,458 psi. Interested parties must file objections or requests for hearing with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505 within 15 days. #34083
